Main tax calculation section with lines 5-25 covering income, deductions, tax, credits, and balance due/refund.

Under penalties of perjury, I declare that I have examined this return, including accompanying schedules and statements, and to the best of my knowledge and belief it is true, correct, and complete.

Signature section with fields for taxpayer, preparer, and spouse's signature, along with date and address.

Table with 6 columns: (a) NAME, (b) Relationship, (c) Months lived in your home, (d) Did dependent have income of \$600 or more?, (e) Amount YOU furnished for dependent's support, (f) Amount furnished by OTHERS including dependent.

Part II Income from sources other than wages, etc.

Part IV Itemized deductions—Use only if you do not use tax table or standard deduction.

Form section for Part II, lines 1a through 1f, including Total line 1a, Exclusion, Capital gain distributions, Nontaxable distributions, and Taxable dividends.

Form section for Part IV, lines 1 through 9, including Medical and dental expense, One-half of insurance premiums, Total cost of medicine and drugs, and Total (add lines 1 and 8).

Form section for Part II, Interest (list payers and amounts below), Earnings from savings and loan assoc. and credit unions, and Other interest.

Form section for Part IV, lines 10 through 13, including Contributions (Cash), Taxes (Real estate, State and local gasoline, General sales, State and local income, Personal property), and Total taxes.

Form section for Part II, lines 2 through 7, including Total interest income, Pensions and annuities, Business income or loss, Sale or exchange of property, Farm income or loss, and Total miscellaneous income.

Form section for Part IV, lines 14 through 15, including Interest expense (Home Mortgage, Installment purchases, Other) and Total interest expense.

Part III Adjustments to income

Form section for Part III, lines 1 through 5, including Sick pay, Moving expenses, Employee business expense, Payments by self-employed persons, and Total Adjustments.

Form section for Part IV, lines 16 through 17, including Total miscellaneous and Total Deductions (add lines 9, 13, 14, 15, and 16).

Part V Credits

Form section for Part V, lines 1 through 4, including Retirement income credit, Investment credit, Foreign tax credit, and Total Credits.
