B. REQUIRED ADDITIONAL COMMENTS TO SUPPORT JD. EXPLAIN RATIONALE FOR DETERMINATION THAT THE REVIEW AREA ONLY INCLUDES DRY LAND: The review area was visited on 9-6-2018 by USACE staff and the applicant. The consultant had delineated three streams within the review area and requested that the upland located immediately upslope of the end of jurisdiction be included in order to receive a No Permit Required Letter for any impacts that would occur outside of jurisdictional waters. Based upon the conducted site visit, there are no indications of a defined bed and bank and an ordinary high water mark within the upland location. The 120 acre

upland consists of upland soils and upland vegetation with minimal evidence of surface flow. Therefore the area is considered uplands and is not considered a Waters of the U.S.
