EXPLAIN RATIONALE FOR DETERMINATION THAT THE REVIEW AREA ONLY INCLUDES DRY LAND:** A desktop review revealed no presence for any wetland parameters or the presence of any waters. The site is not near any stream or floodplain. A review of aerial photography indicates the site has been in active agricultural production for decades. Partial hydric soils are mapped on a portion of the site, however the site appears to be tiled and well drained. Site is entirely dry land.
