Wetland A	0.15 acres	(b)(1) Non-adjacent wetland	Primary source of hydrology is stated as high-water table and overland sheet flow from surrounding forested and agricultural fields. Wetland A displays no discernable connection to Waters of the U.S, is a (b)(1) water, and is therefore excluded from the rule.
