**Typical year assessment(s):** ): The Antecedent Precipitation Tool (APT) was used to evaluate climatic conditions for the date of the site visit, April 27, 2021. The APT analysis shows that precipitation and climatic conditions were within the normal periodic range, therefore typical year conditions were present. Additionally, Weather Underground rainfall records were obtained from the weather station located at the Cincinnati/Northern Kentucky International Airport for dates prior to the site visit. Records show 0.2 inches of precipitation fell 2 days prior to the site visit on April 25, 2021, and 0.0 inches fell on the date of the site visit. No water was observed in Ephemeral Stream 12

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during the field visit. As typical year conditions were present, and no flow was observed in Ephemeral Stream 12 following 0.2 inches of rainfall in the preceding 2 days, the assessment provides further evidence that Ephemeral 12 is an ephemeral feature.
