	Type of Recruitment Initiative (Menu Selection)	Brief Description of Activity
1	Participate in Job Fair	On March 4, 2015, our SEU participated in the Diversity Employment Fair held at the Holiday Inn Conference Center in Washington, DC. The Fair brought together DC's major employers with thousands of qualified, diverse professionals with the aim to recruit, promote and reaffirm commitment to diversity in the workplace. SEU representatives occupied a booth and spoke with numerous interested attendees about career opportunities in broadcasting and job openings within the SEU. SEU participants included our Director of Marketing.
2	Participate in Job Fair	On June 11, 2014, our SEU participated in the annual job fair at Howard University Media Sales Institute sponsored by the National Association of Broadcasters Education Foundation. SEU representatives listened intently to numerous presentations made by student applicants from Historical Black Colleges and Universities from across the country and selected students that they wished to interview. Interviews were conducted on-site between 2:00 p.m. and 6:00 p.m. SEU participants included the General Sales Manager of WRQX-FM and the General Sales Manager of WMAL-AM/FM. One student was hired as an Account Executive for WRQX-FM.

3	Internship Program (2)	Each Station in our SEU has established a College Internship Program designed to assist qualified students to acquire the skills necessary to obtain employment in the broadcast industry, while allowing the student to gain school credit. The duration of an internship is typically three to four months, depending on the length of the school semester. Interns are recruited by notifying area colleges/universities regarding internship openings as well as through student-initiated contacts. Each department creates a department-specific program, however, an intern's duties generally include providing assistance with various sales related tasks, promotional events, on-air remote broadcasts, cutting audio clips, creating videos on YouTube, posting on Social Media, writing news stories based on newsmaker interviews, updating the morning show website and other various duties in our newsroom.
		During this reporting period the Promotions department for WMAL(AM)/-FM and WRQX hosted four (4) interns, one (1) from each of the following universities: Salisbury University; Pennsylvania State University; University of Miami; and, Marymount University.
		Additionally, WMAL(AM)/-FM hosted three (3) interns in its News and Programming departments, one (1) from Patrick Henry College-National Journalism Center, one (1) from University of Maryland, and one (1) from George Washington University.
