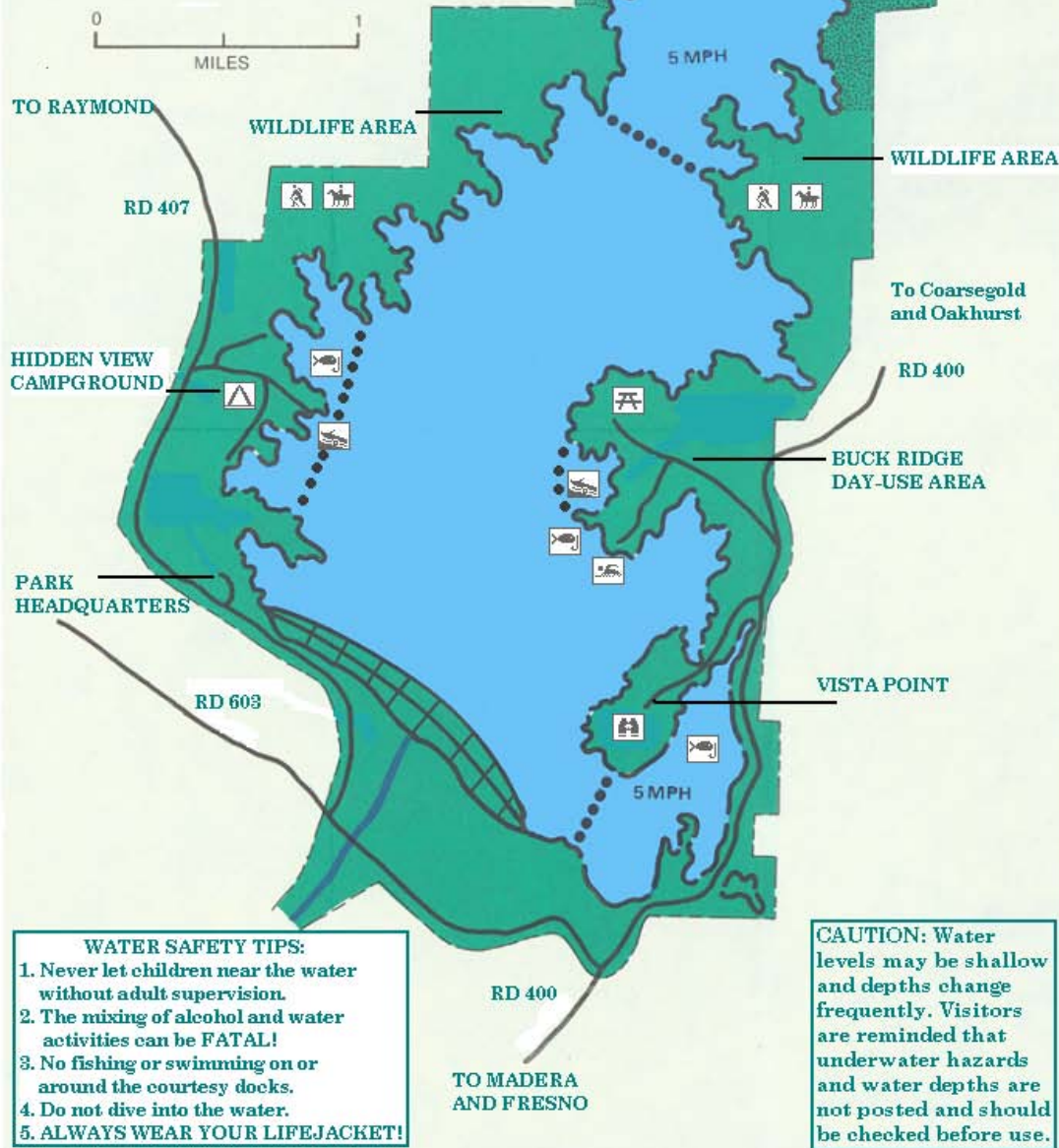

- WATER SAFETY TIPS:**
1. Never let children near the water without adult supervision.
 2. The mixing of alcohol and water activities can be FATAL!
 3. No fishing or swimming on or around the courtesy docks.
 4. Do not dive into the water.
 5. ALWAYS WEAR YOUR LIFEJACKET!

CAUTION: Water levels may be shallow and depths change frequently. Visitors are reminded that underwater hazards and water depths are not posted and should be checked before use.

Rules & Regulations

- Campfires & camping are restricted to campground only
- Vehicles permitted on road ways only
- Pets must be kept on a six foot leash at all times
- All permits must be visibly displayed
- Destruction, injury, defacement or removal of public property including vegetation, natural and cultural resources is prohibited

FISH LIMITS

- * Large Mouth Bass = 2 over 15 inches
- * Bluegill & Crappie - Combined Limit = 25
- * Catfish = no limit
- * Rainbow Trout = 5
- Crappie = 25

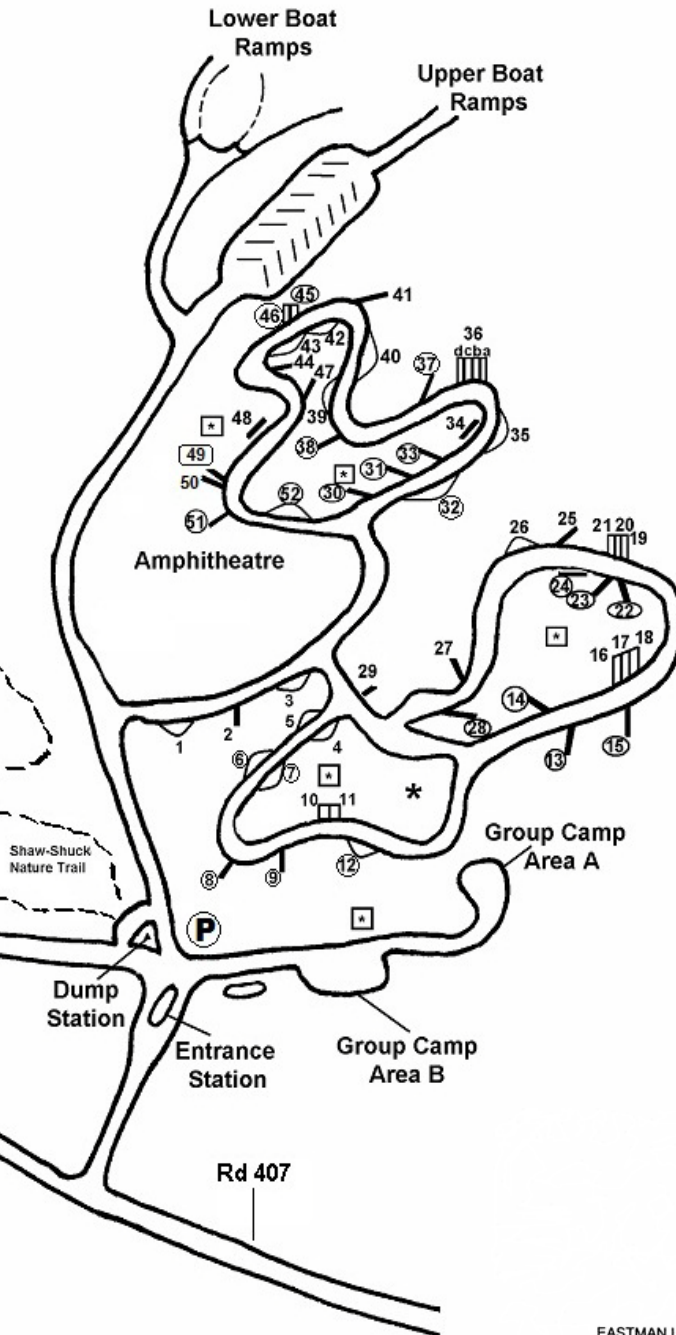
HIDDEN VIEW CAMPGROUND



Fishing Access

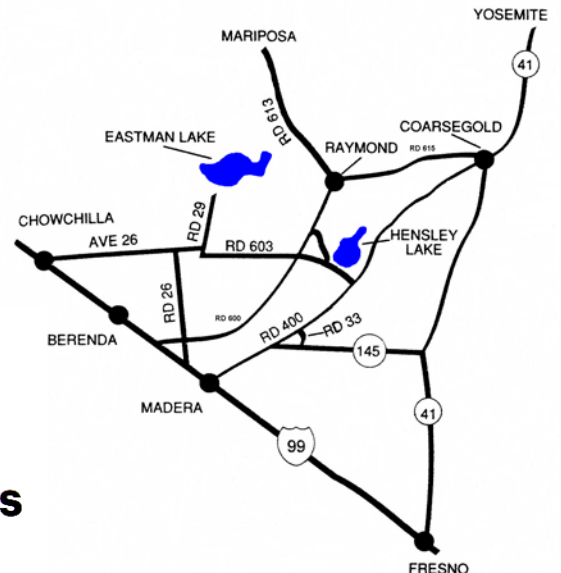
Pohonichi Trail

Camping Rules

1. Campground gate closes at 10:00 pm
2. Quiet hours are between 10 pm and 6 am
3. 10-person limit per site
4. Check out time is noon.
5. Keep campsite clean, take trash to bins
6. Keep fire rings free of glass and trash
7. Camping is limited to 14 days out of any 30 day period
8. Dispose of all drain water and sewage in the campground dump station
9. Do not gather standing vegetation for firewood
10. No day use allowed in campground
