

Guide to Hunting at Hensley Lake Recreation Area

Hunting Rules:

- All California Department of Fish and Game, along with all state and local regulations apply.
- Hunting is permitted by shotgun and archery <u>only</u>.
 <u>No rifles</u>, air guns, slingshots, or other projectile devices are allowed. Slugs for shotgun are permitted.
- The wildlife areas are shared by hunters, hikers, bikers, horseback riders, and pets. Be alert and aware of other people in the area.
- All weapons must be unloaded while being transported and cased or otherwise rendered inoperable in the campgrounds and other public day use areas.

Hunting is prohibited in and adjacent to the following

areas:

- Hidden View Recreation Area
- **Buck Ridge Recreation Area**
- **Vista Point**
- **•** In the area of the Park Headquarters
- Area West of the River

The area is primarily oak trees and grasslands. The topography is typical of the Sierra foothills ranging from gentle to steep slopes. Hunting from a boat is permitted away from campgrounds, boat ramps, and other developed areas in accordance with California Fish and Game regulations. Canada goose and Mallard ducks are the most common.
