WHEREAS: The Centers for Disease Control and Prevention is leading *Active People, Healthy Nation*, an initiative to help 27 million Americans become more physically active by 2027; and

WHEREAS: Chester County is committed to supporting a thriving, vibrant, and healthier community for residents of all ages and abilities, and recognizes the importance of providing safe and convenient places to be physically active for people regardless of age, race, income, socio-economic status, disability status and geographic location; and



in Chester County, recognizing that options for, and encouragement of physical activity contributes to the health of all communities.


