Subject: Beginning May 26, 2020, NWS Will Proceed with Providing NWS Data in Geospatial Formats

NWS plans to provide more of its operational data in standard geospatial formats so the data may be seamlessly ingested into user systems independent of platform operating system, development software, and/or native data formats, beginning May 26, 2020.

The NWS provides data sets in formats that can be imported directly into Geographic Information Systems (GIS), a user's custom map viewer or web pages. The data formats include downloadable shapefiles, web services, and Keyhole Markup Language (KML) files, such as what is listed at:

Data in standard geospatial formats may be provided for both existing operational products/data and future operational products/data, based on readiness and resource availability.

Such efforts will be covered by the aforementioned SDD and will not undergo additional public comment/review beyond what is done in conjunction with standard approval of any new/enhanced products/data.
