Subject: Updated: Changes in Fire and Public Zones for NWS
 Weather Forecast Office Jacksonville, FL, for
 Clay, Duval and Putnam Counties in Florida:
 Effective March 30, 2021

Updated to correct Universal Generic Code (UGC) for new
forecast zones of Eastern Clay, Western Clay, Eastern
Putnam, and Western Putnam.

On or about March 30, 2021 at 200 PM Eastern Daylight Time
(EDT), 1800 Coordinated Universal Time (UTC), three county
public and fire weather forecast zones for NWS Weather
Forecast Office (WFO) Jacksonville (JAX), FL, will be
adjusted into different zones.

If March 30, 2021 is declared a Critical Weather Day, this
implementation will be postponed to April 1, 2021.

The Clay County forecast zone in Florida, will be divided
to create eastern and western Clay County Zones.

Inland Duval County forecast zone will be split to create a
new Western Duval Zone, South Central Duval Zone, and Trout
River Zone.

Putnam County forecast zone will be divided to create
eastern and western Putnam County Zones.

These changes are intended to provide increased flexibility and improved accuracy of forecast, watches, warnings and advisories in the public and fire weather programs and will lead to better service during tropical and coastal flooding events.

The Fire and Public Zone changes require partners and users to take appropriate action to receive the new Zone products using the Universal Generic Code (UGC) zone code format (Z) listed in Table 2.
