Subject: Addition of Year-Round Fire Weather Planning Forecasts:
Effective March 15, 2022 in Central and Western Wyoming

Effective Tuesday, March 15, 2022, the National Weather Service (NWS) Weather Forecast Office in Riverton, WY, will begin issuing morning Fire Weather Planning Forecasts (FWFRIW) daily throughout the year. This product is currently provided seasonally. This addition will not involve changes to World Meteorological Organization (WMO) Headers or Advanced Weather Interactive Processing System (AWIPS) Product Identifiers.
