The NWS Climate Prediction Center is discontinuing the Experimental Two-Class Seasonal Forecast effective September 15, 2022. This decision is made in response to an ongoing need to maintain consistent messaging in the context of the NWS operational climate forecasts, which are all either currently in a three-class format, or moving to that format in the near future.

The NWS Climate Prediction Center continues to issue the operational three-class, probabilistic seasonal forecast products in both standard graphic, GIS and Google Earth formats, on the third Thursday of each month:
