Garden Highway Closure for Levee Repairs

Food services and businesses are open. Take alternate routes.

I-5 to Gateway Oaks Drive Closure

Garden Highway will be completely closed to all vehicle and bicycle traffic in Sacramento from I-5 west to Gateway Oaks Drive from April 23 through the end of May 2020 for levee repair work. The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers is continuing work on the Lower Natomas Basin Levee Improvement Project. This flood risk reduction work was authorized by Congress in 2014 to shore up the existing levee system, making the Natomas Basin safer.

Closure Start Date: April 23, 2020

Estimated Completion: May 31, 2020

Businesses Remain Open: Use Alternate Route

Businesses remain open along Garden Highway, including **Chevys** and **The Virgin Sturgeon** restaurants are open for take-out meals and can be reached via the alternate routes. Other businesses along Garden Highway remain open as well, including **Riverbank Marina, NorCal Mastercraft, River City Yacht and Boat Sales, Carefree Boat Club, Outsourced Legal Solutions, Law Offices of Alan Donato, Law Offices of Ryan Friedman, NeuroVision, and Piece of Mind.**
