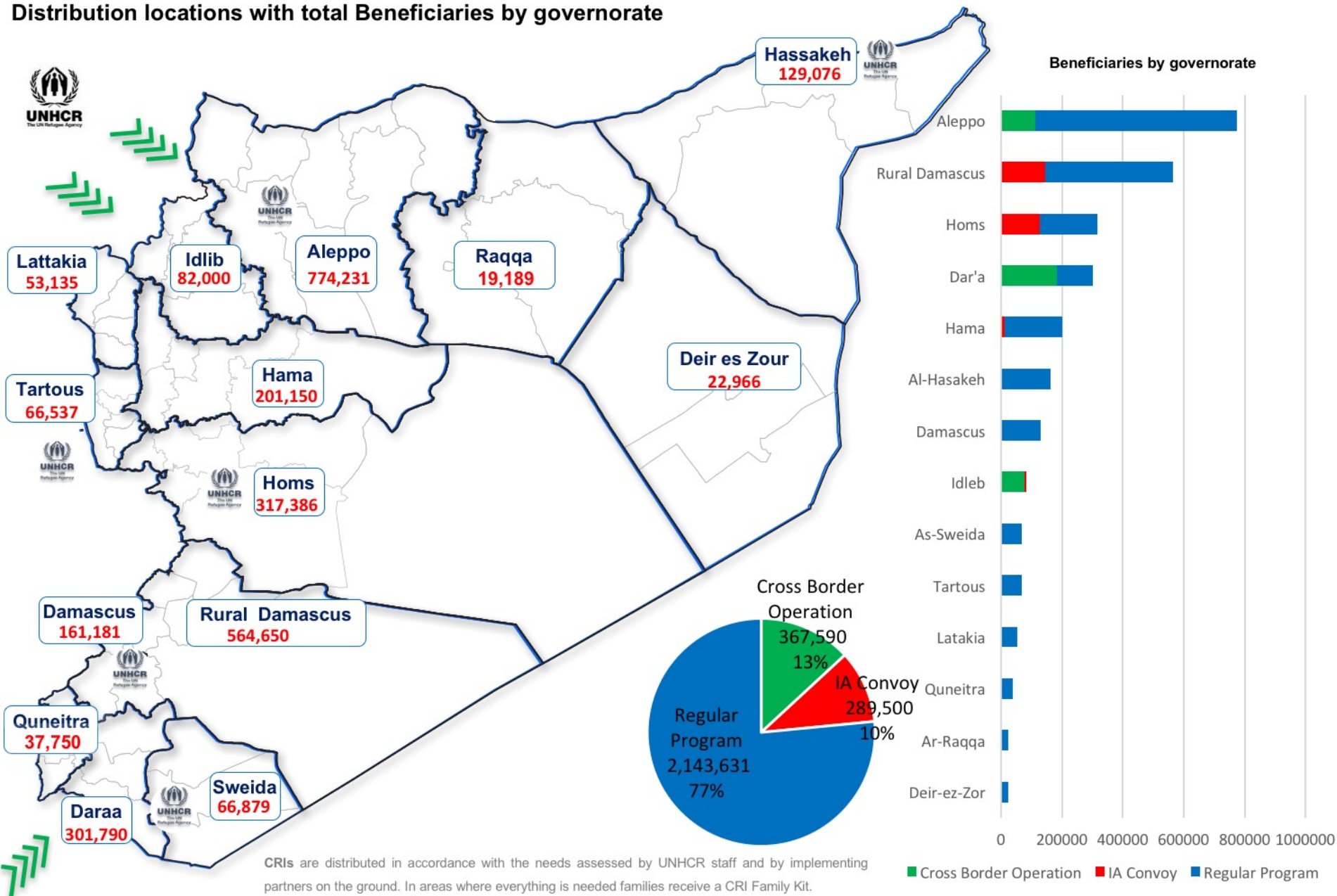

Distribution locations with total Beneficiaries by governorate

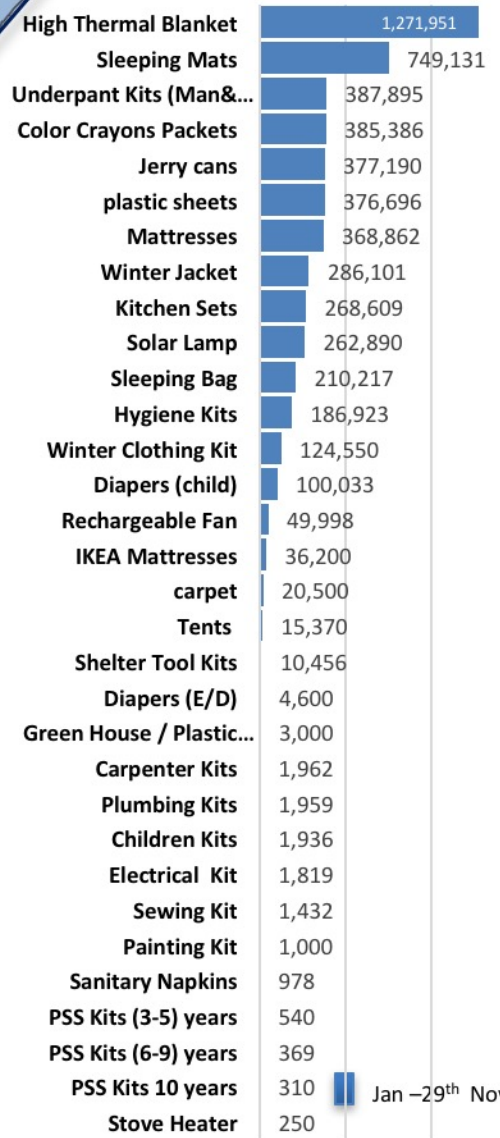
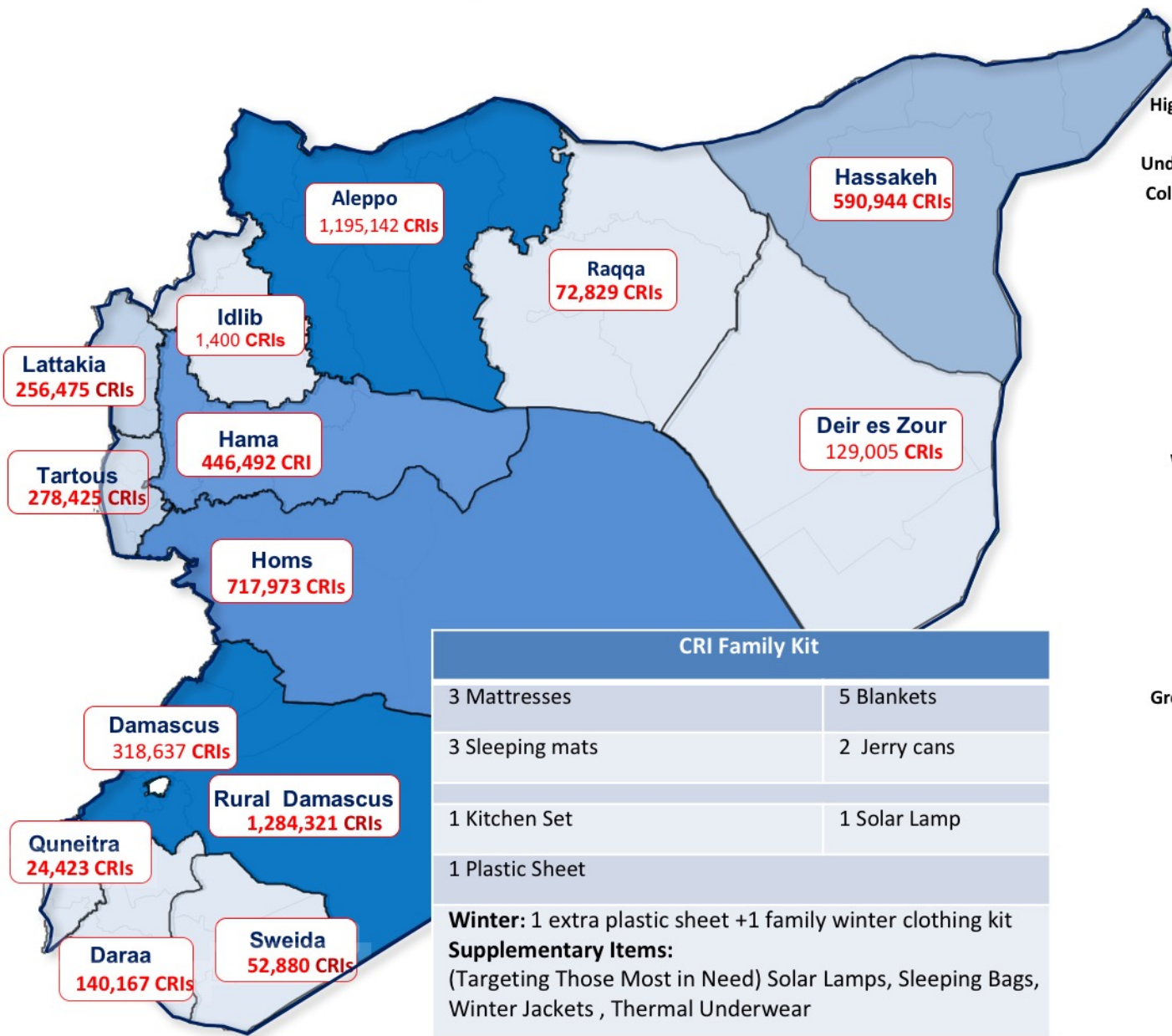

So far in 2017 UNHCR Dispatched 5,509,113 CRIs to the 14 Governorates as of 29/11/2017

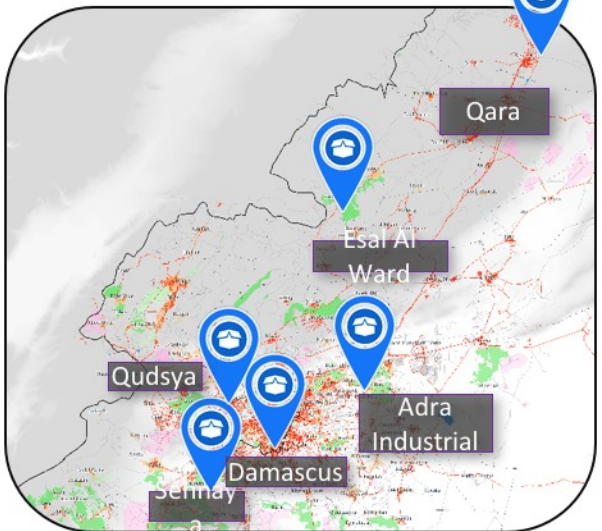
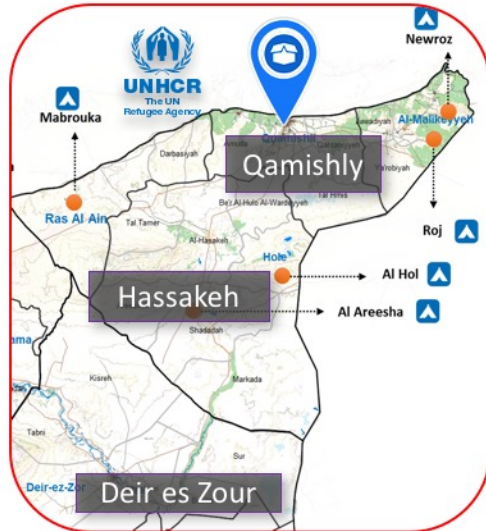
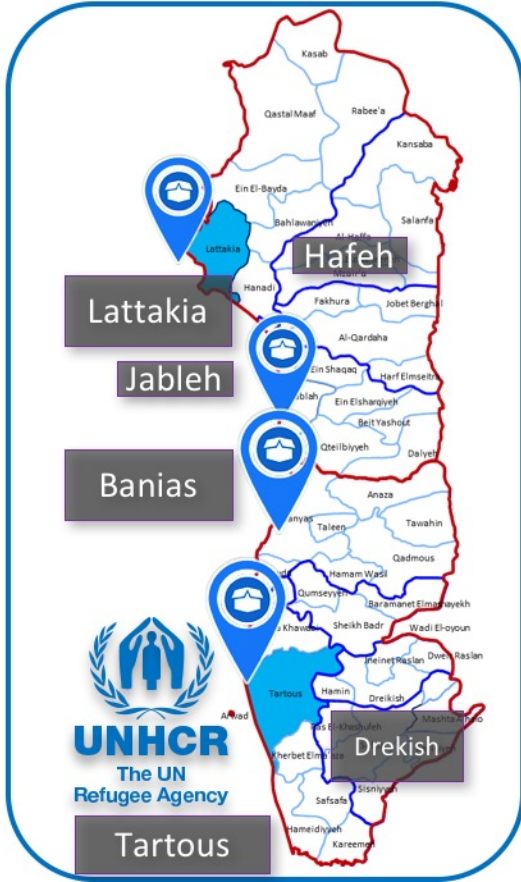
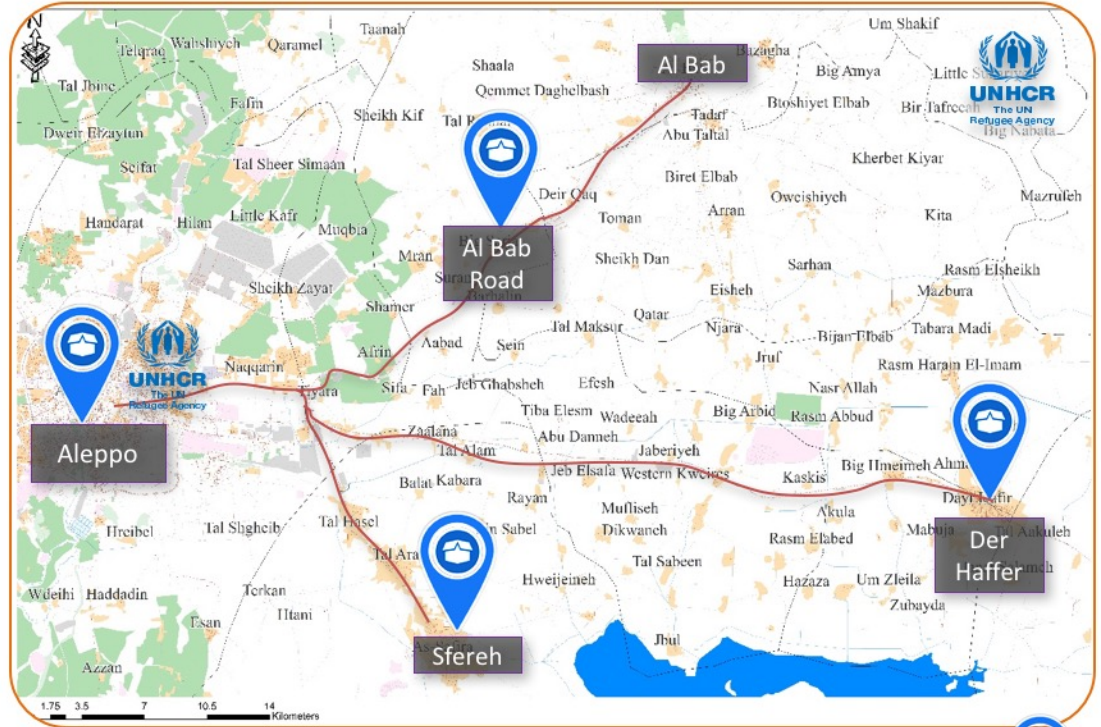
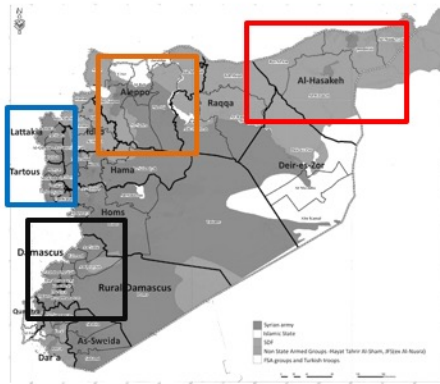

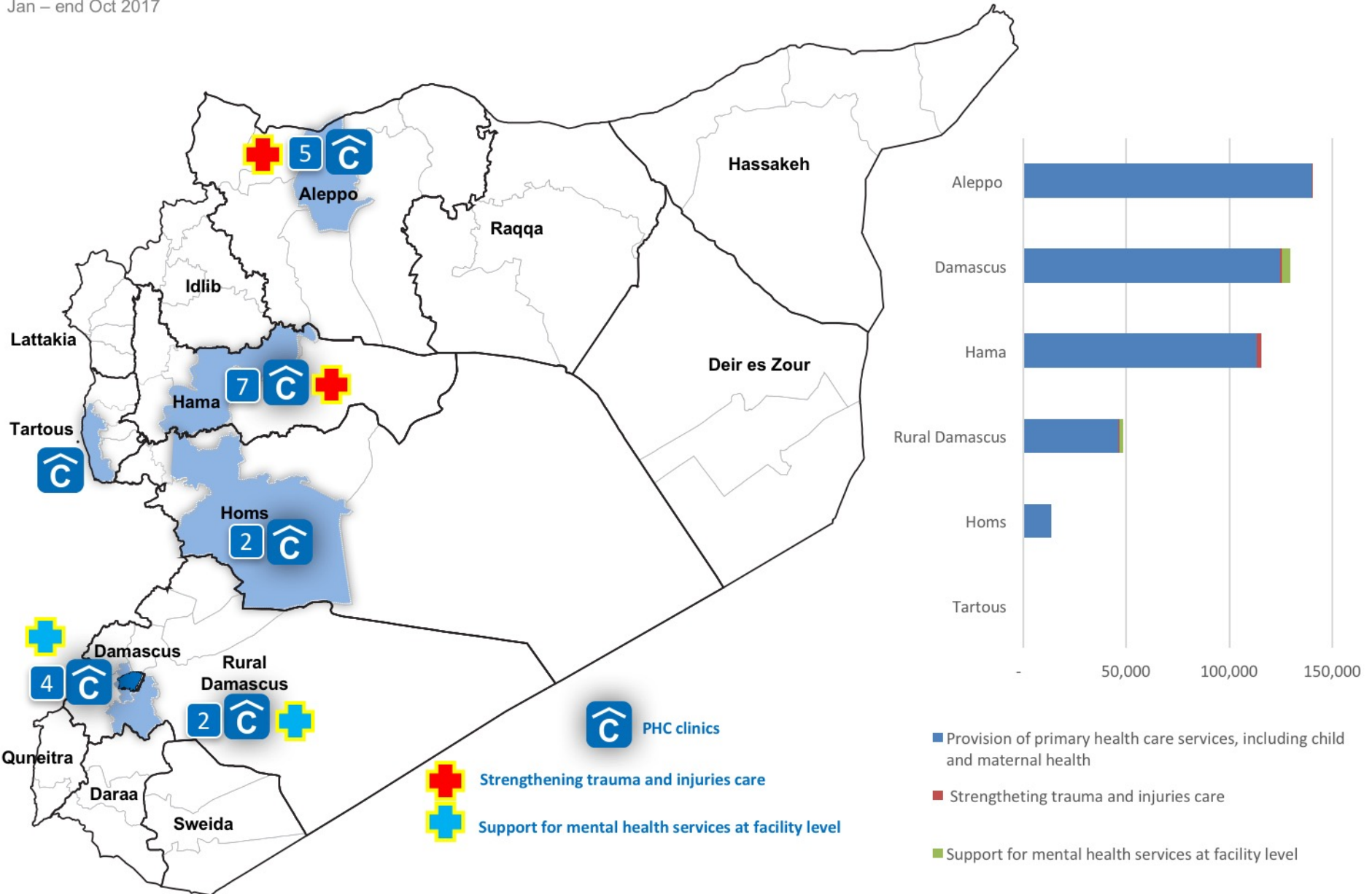


Main Locations of CRIs Distribution from 20/11/2017 to 29/11/2017



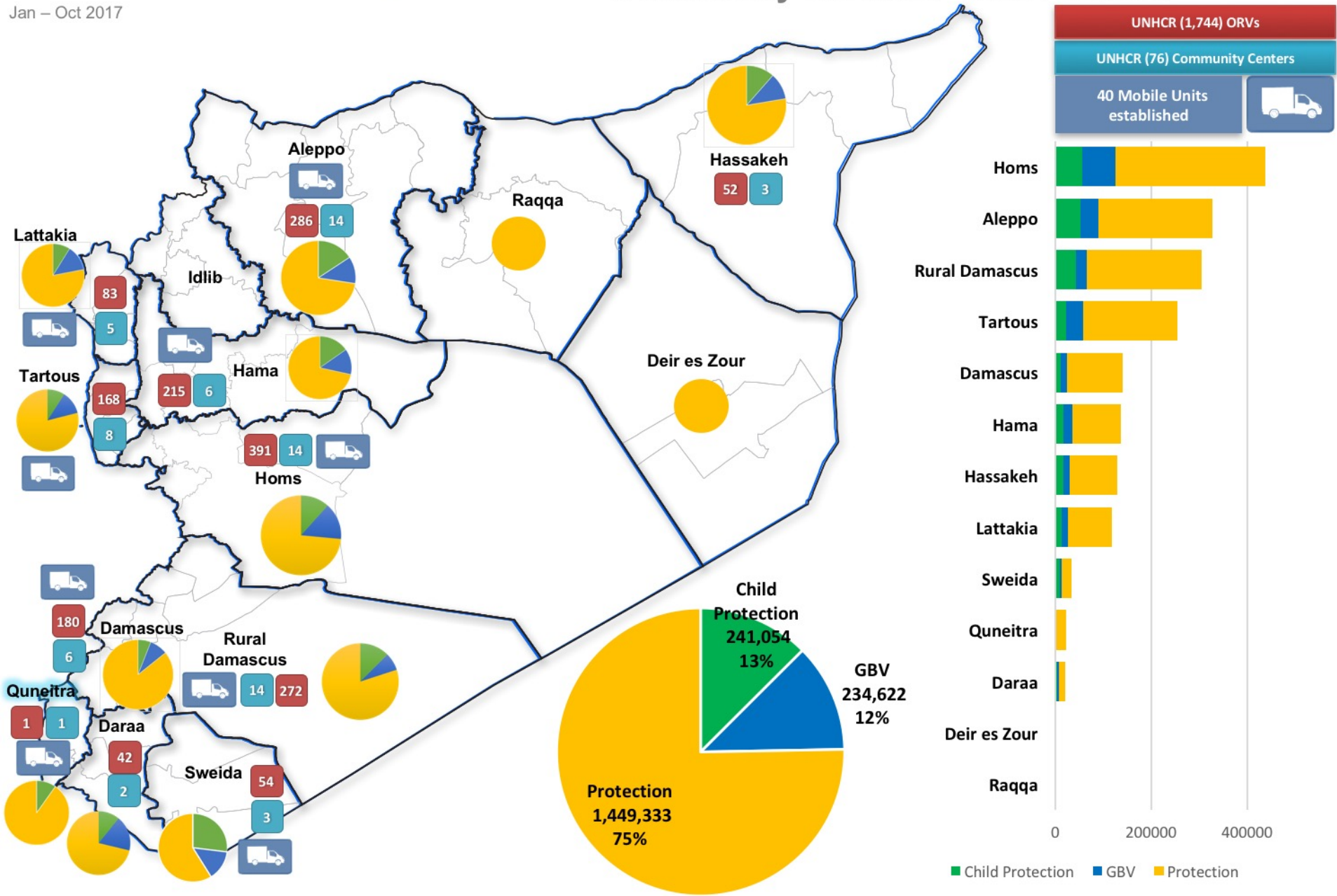
