1	Event Designed to Disseminate Information About Broadcast Careers	This is an on-going activity where we broadcast an on-air promotion to recruit organizations who would like to receive our job openings. Participants from the station included the Office Manager/EEO Coordinator, Sales Coordinator and Creative Services Director.
2	Event Designed to Disseminate Information About Broadcast Careers	KAIT maintains an on-going speaker's bureau program with local organizations and schools who invite KAIT employees to speak about various television broadcasting topics including diversity, inclusion, and career opportunities. During the reporting period KAIT spoke with several different groups including a Zoom meeting with a group of University of Alabama/WVUA students on March 3, 2022; a group of Arkansas State University graduating seniors from the College of Journalism on April 28, 2022; a group of Freshmen MMJ and Digital Media students from Arkansas State University on August 29, 2022; a group of Freshmen and Sophomores from Arkansas State University's Digital Media Production class on October 13, 2022; a group of upper classmen from Arkansas State University's Strategic Writing class on October 19, 2022; a Riverside High School Career Day presentation on November 4, 2022; and a group of Southside Charter High School students doing mock job interviews. Participants from the station included several Multi-Media Journalists, Creative Services Director, News Director, and a News Anchor.

3	Event Designed to Disseminate Information About Broadcast Careers	KAIT maintains an on-going job shadow program with local junior high, senior high, and college students throughout the reporting period. The students spend a day or more following an employee or employees in the area of their choice to discuss opportunities, seek advice on a future career in broadcasting and learn new technologies associated with the industry. During the reporting period KAIT hosted four 8th grade students from 3 different local junior high schools. 4	Participated in EEO Training	On February 17, 2022, Joan Stewart of Wiley Rein, LLP provided FCC Equal Employment Opportunity Rules training via webinar to Gray employees. The webinar covered topics such as recruitment, recordkeeping, and reporting. KAIT's General Manager and Office Manager attended the webinar.
