

**NATIONAL CEMETERY ADMINISTRATION
AUTOMATED INFORMATION SYSTEMS SECURITY**

1. PURPOSE: This notice officially rescinds National Cemetery Administration (NCA) Directive 6210 – Automated Information Systems Security, and NCA Handbook 6210 – Automated Information Systems Security Procedures, both published April 10, 2006.

2. BACKGROUND:

a. NCA Directive and Handbook 6210 were issued prior to publication of department-level guidance. With the publication of Department of Veterans Affairs (VA) Directive 6500 – Information Security Program (August 4, 2006) and VA Handbook 6500 - Information Security Program (September 18, 2007), NCA has no need for separate guidance in this subject area.

b. This notice is issued to clarify that NCA management officials and staff will follow the policies, procedures and guidelines published in VA Directive and Handbook 6500 to implement an effective information security program at all NCA facilities.

3. ACTION:

a. All NCA staff should follow the guidance in VA Directive and Handbook 6500, available electronically through the VA website at <http://www1.va.gov/vapubs/>.

b. NCA Information Technology and Business Requirements Service will keep NCA staff informed of VA information security program requirements.
