

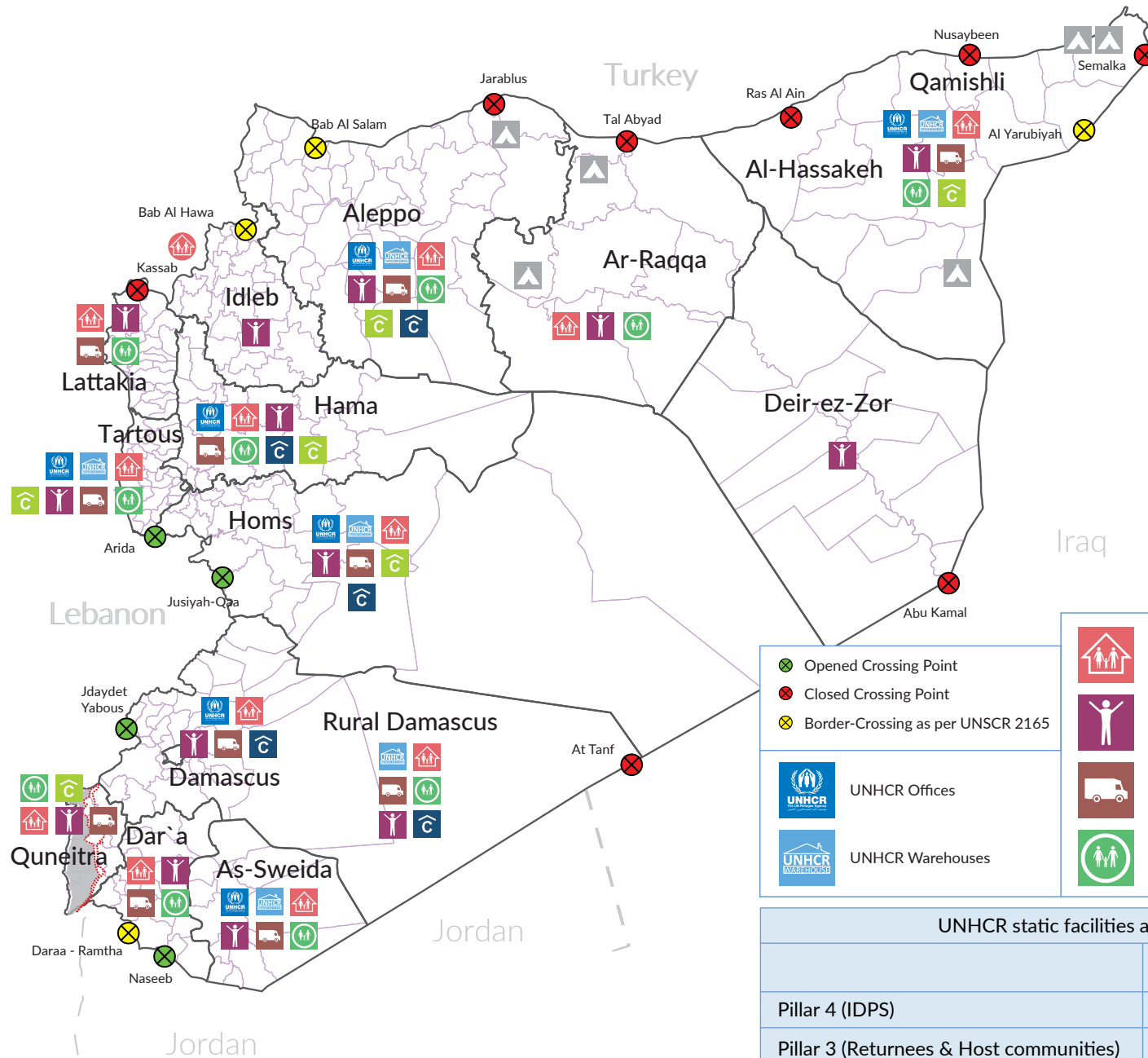


# UNHCR - Syria

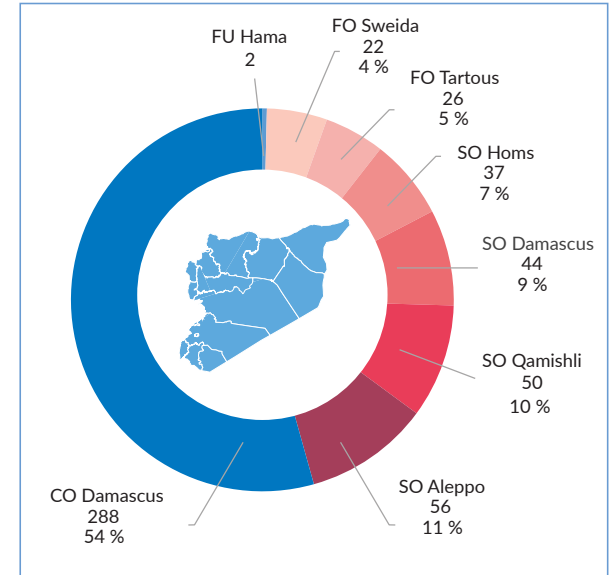
Main Activities

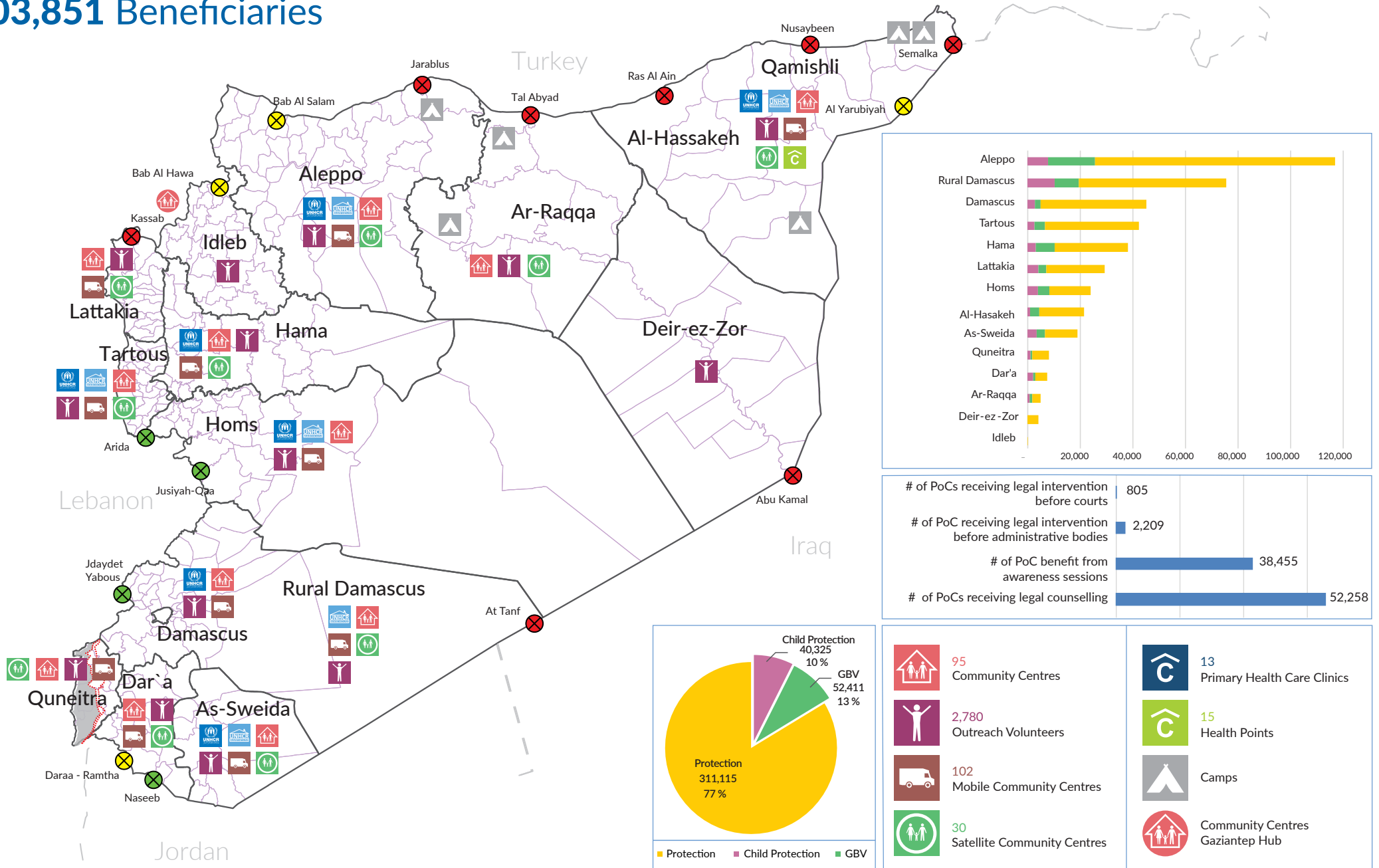

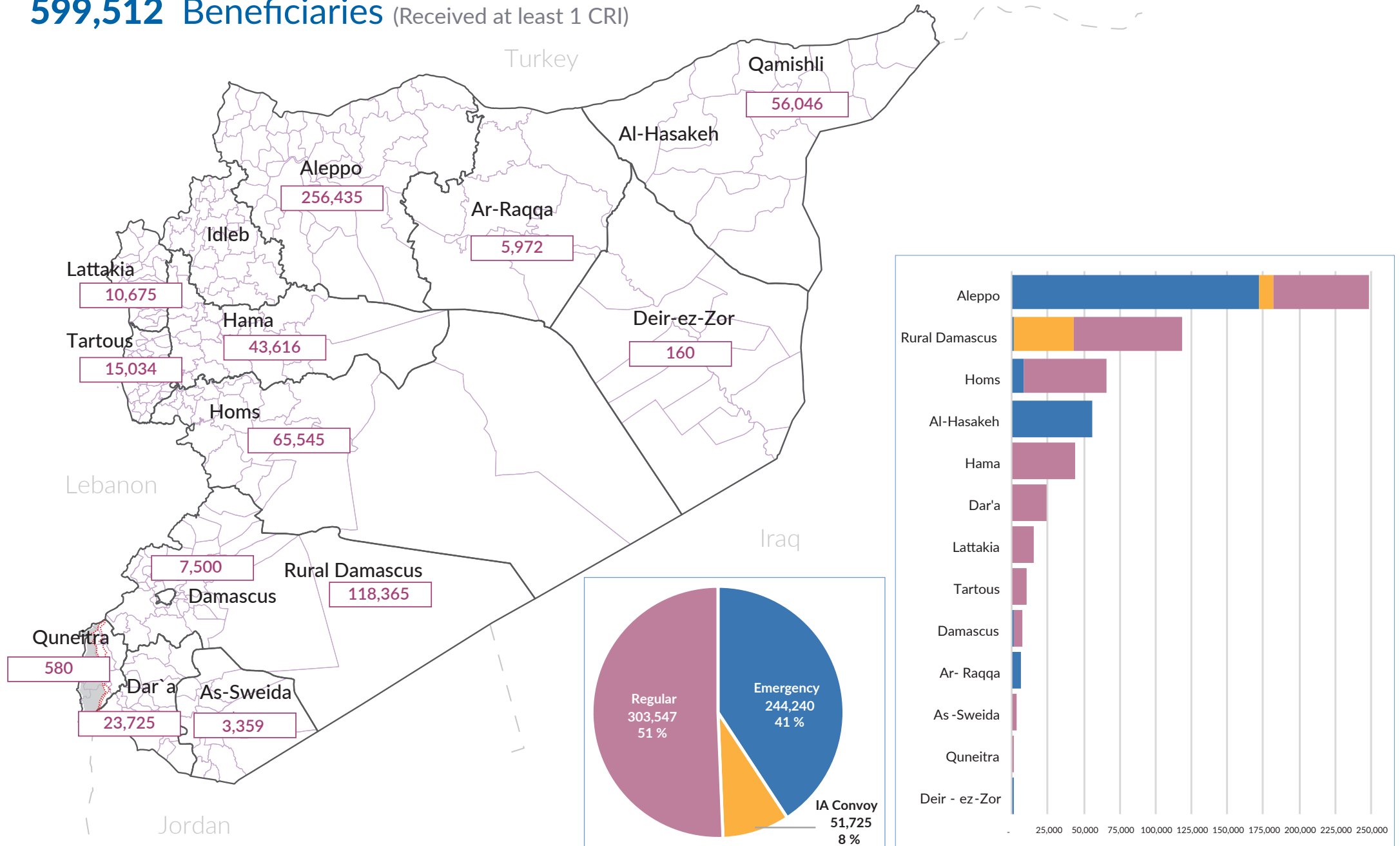

## 403,851 Beneficiaries



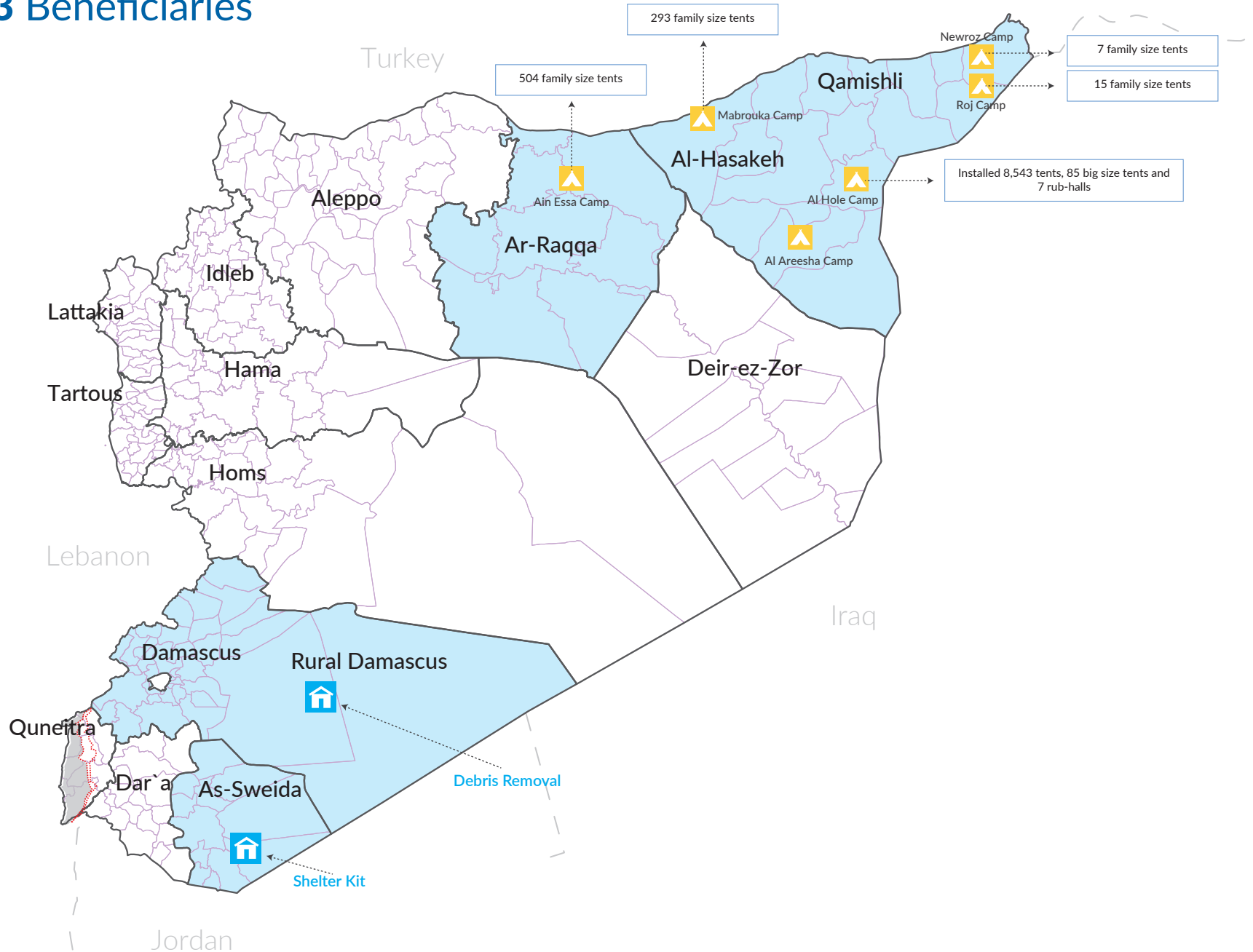
# UNHCR SYRIA CORE RELIEF ITEM DISTRIBUTION

**599,512** Beneficiaries (Received at least 1 CRI)



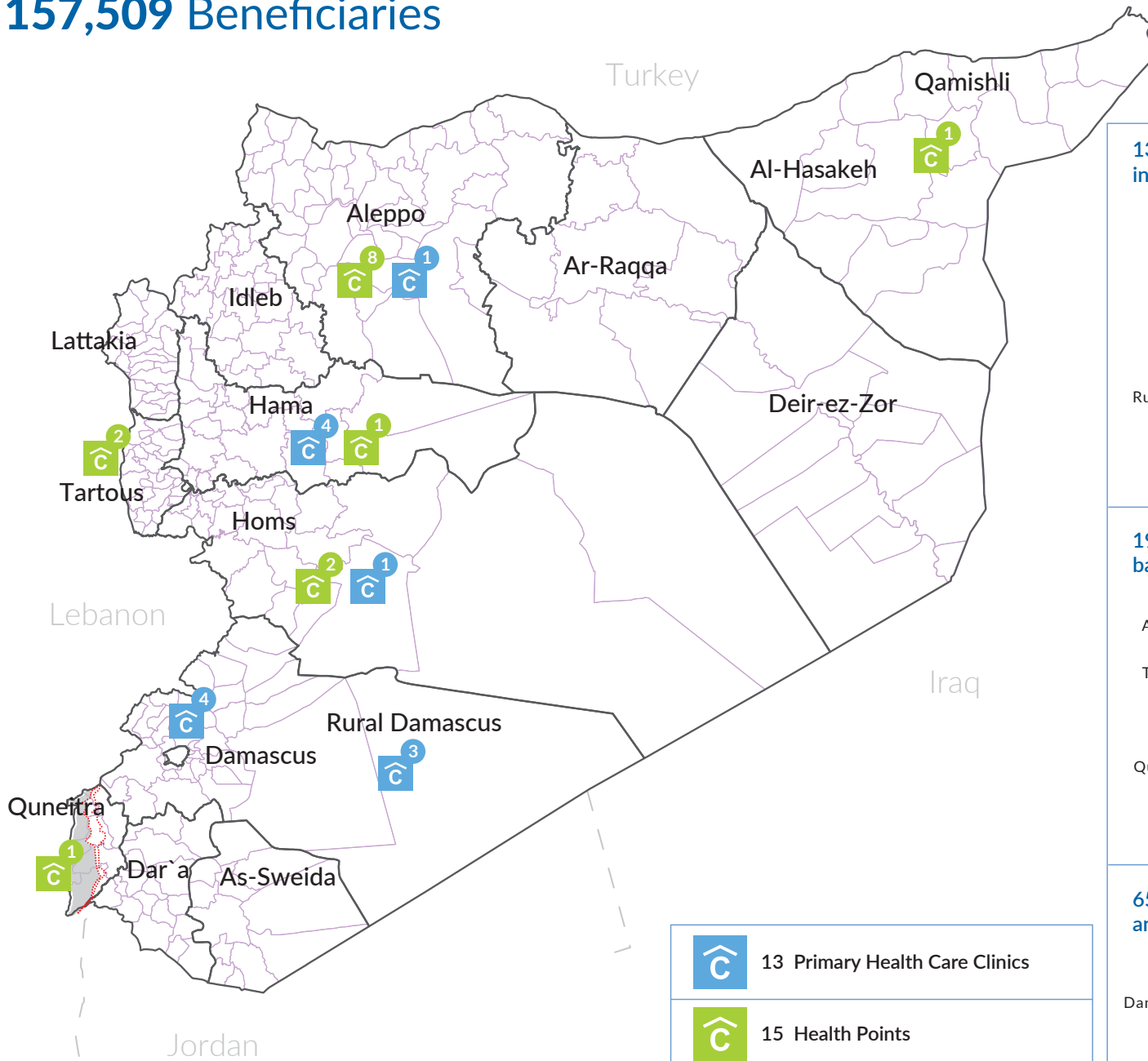

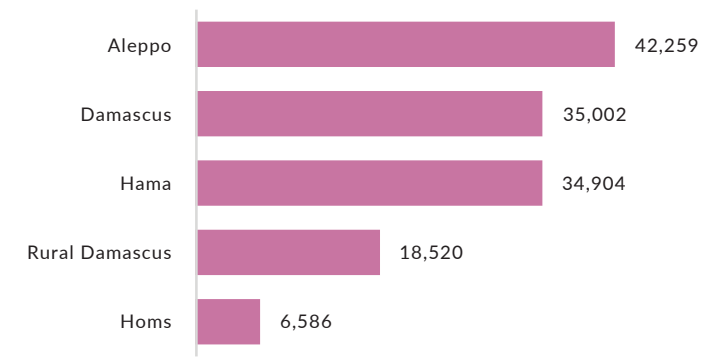

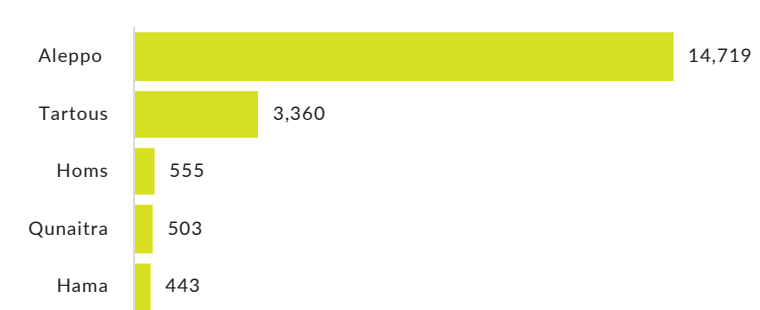

### 19,580 person of concerns reached by community based health activities



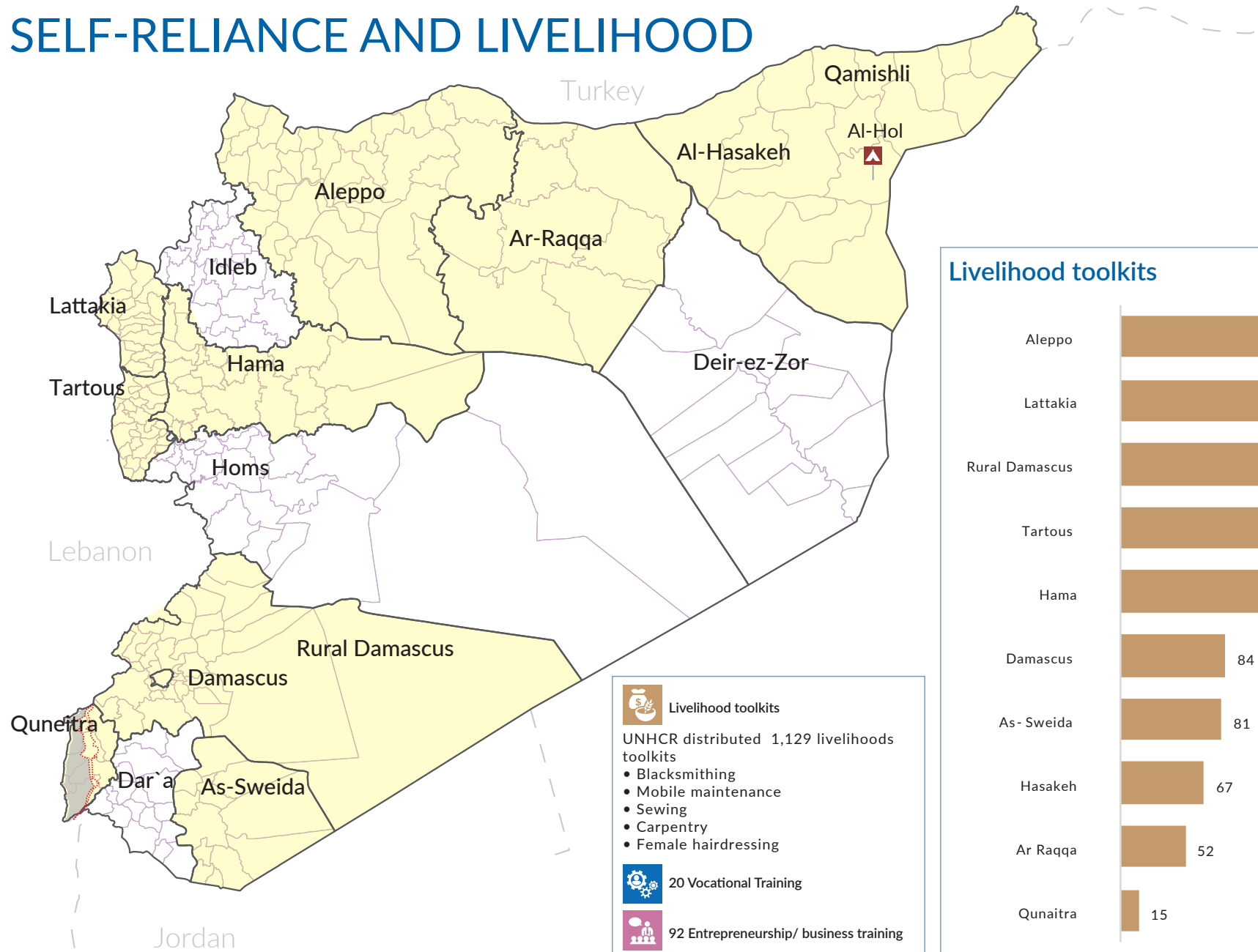

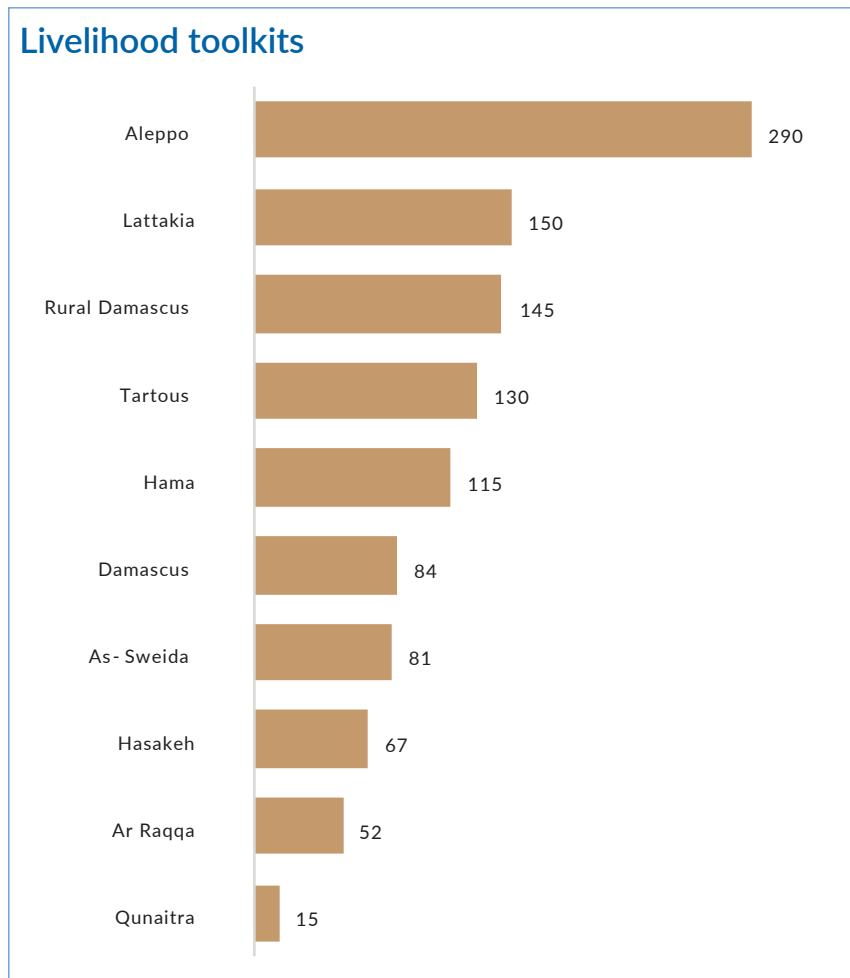

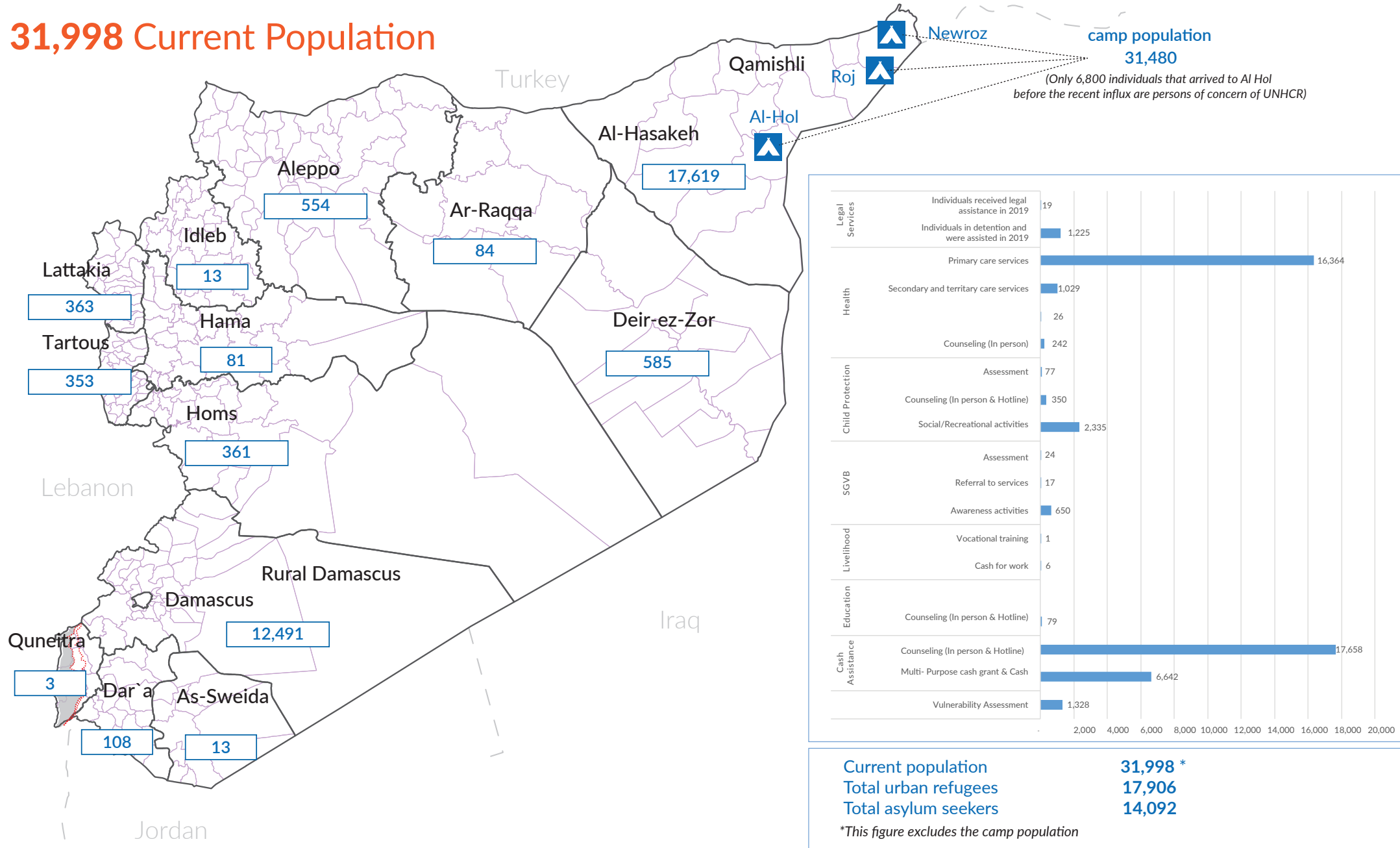

## 31,998 Current Population



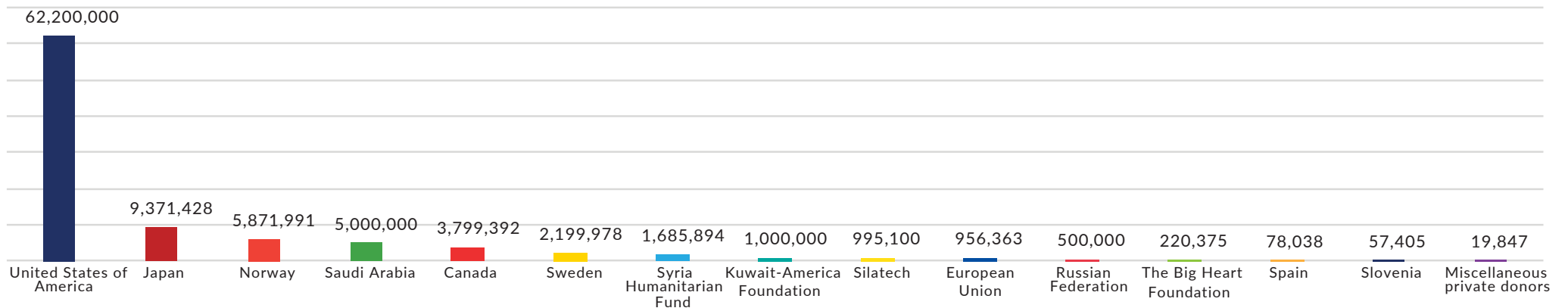
