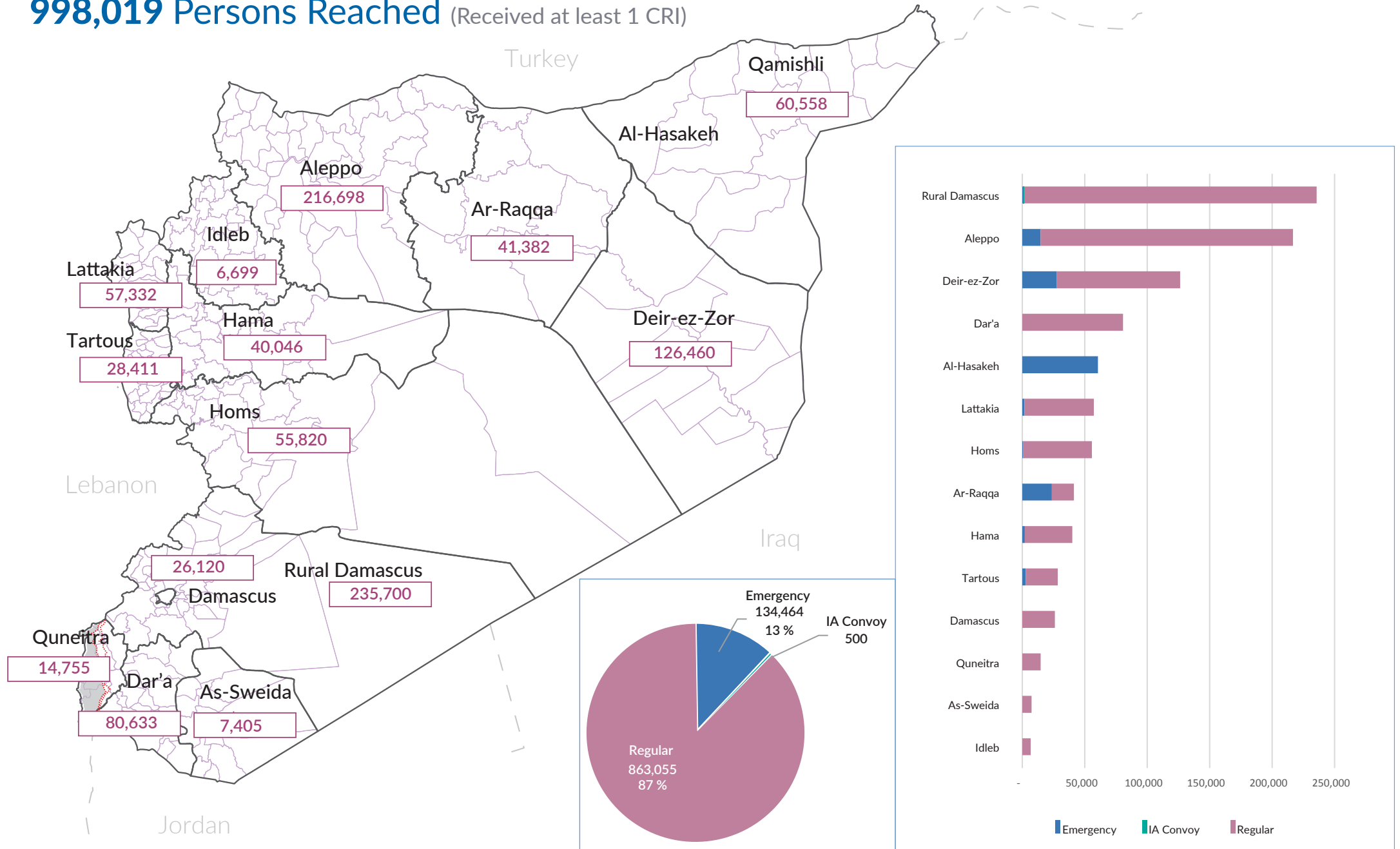

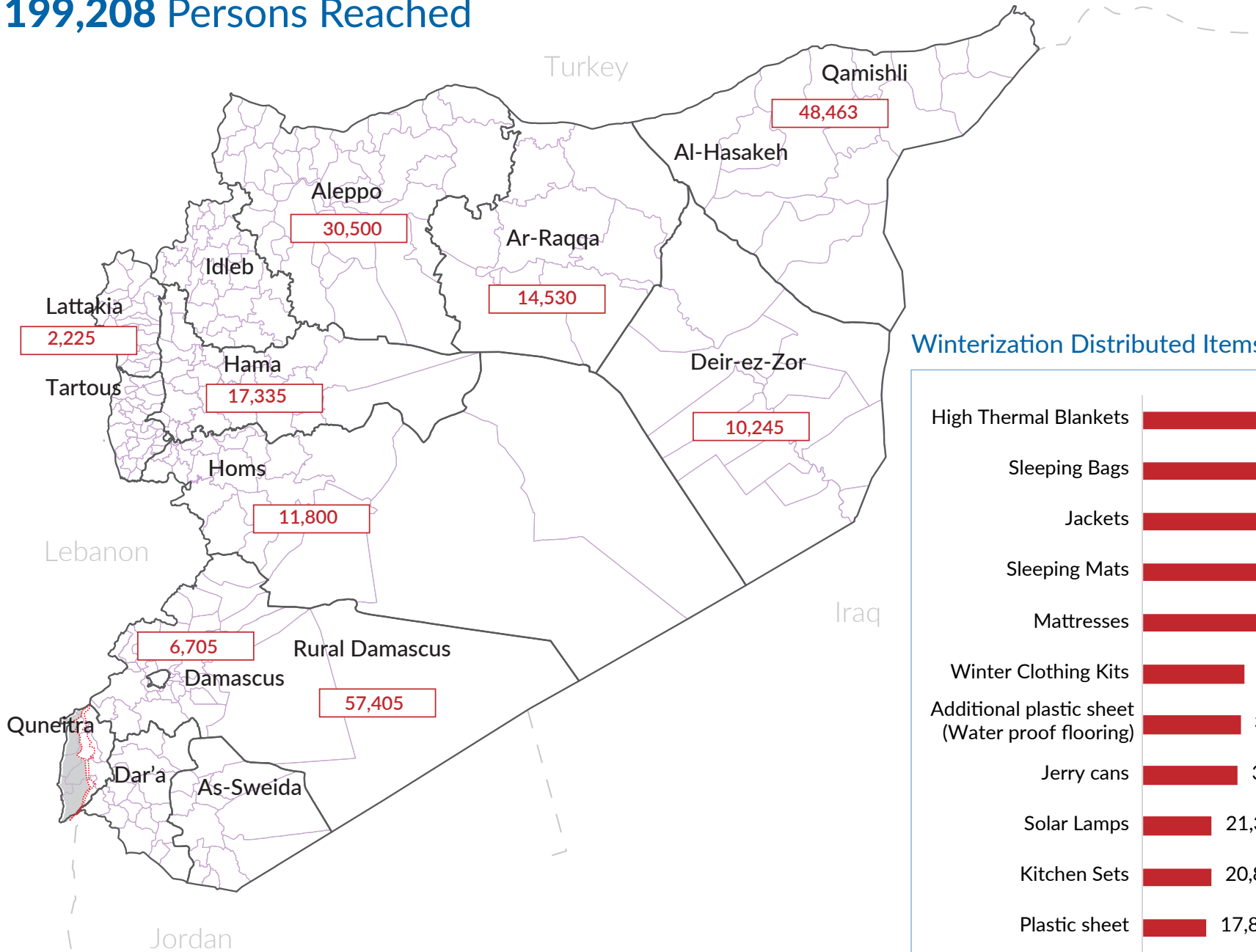

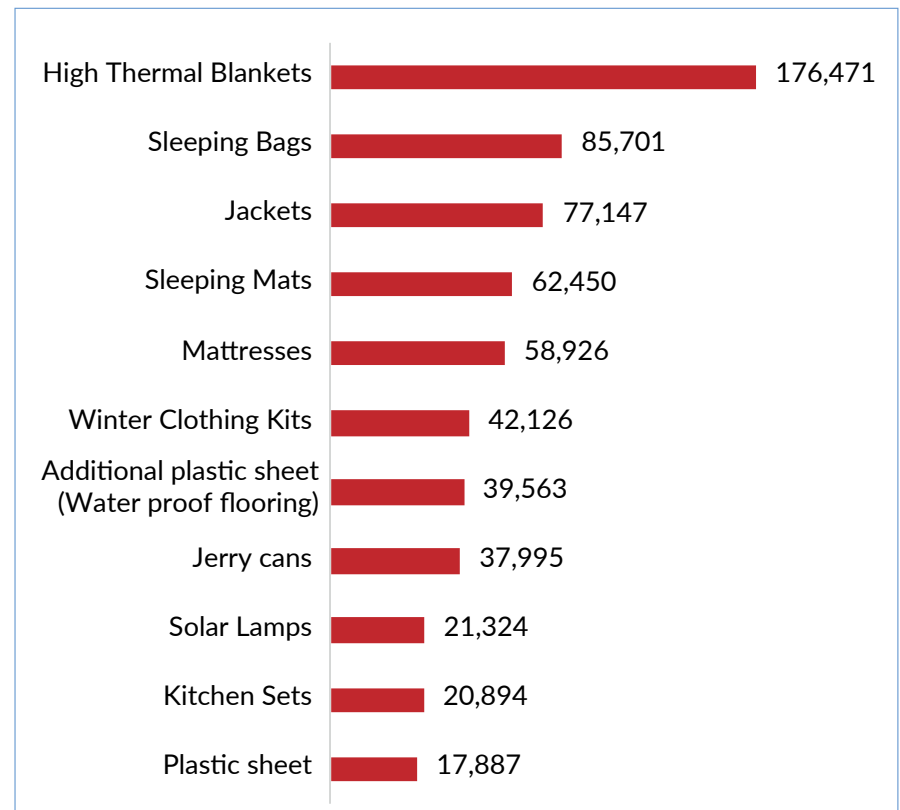


UNHCR SYRIA WINTERIZATION PROGRAMME 2020/2021

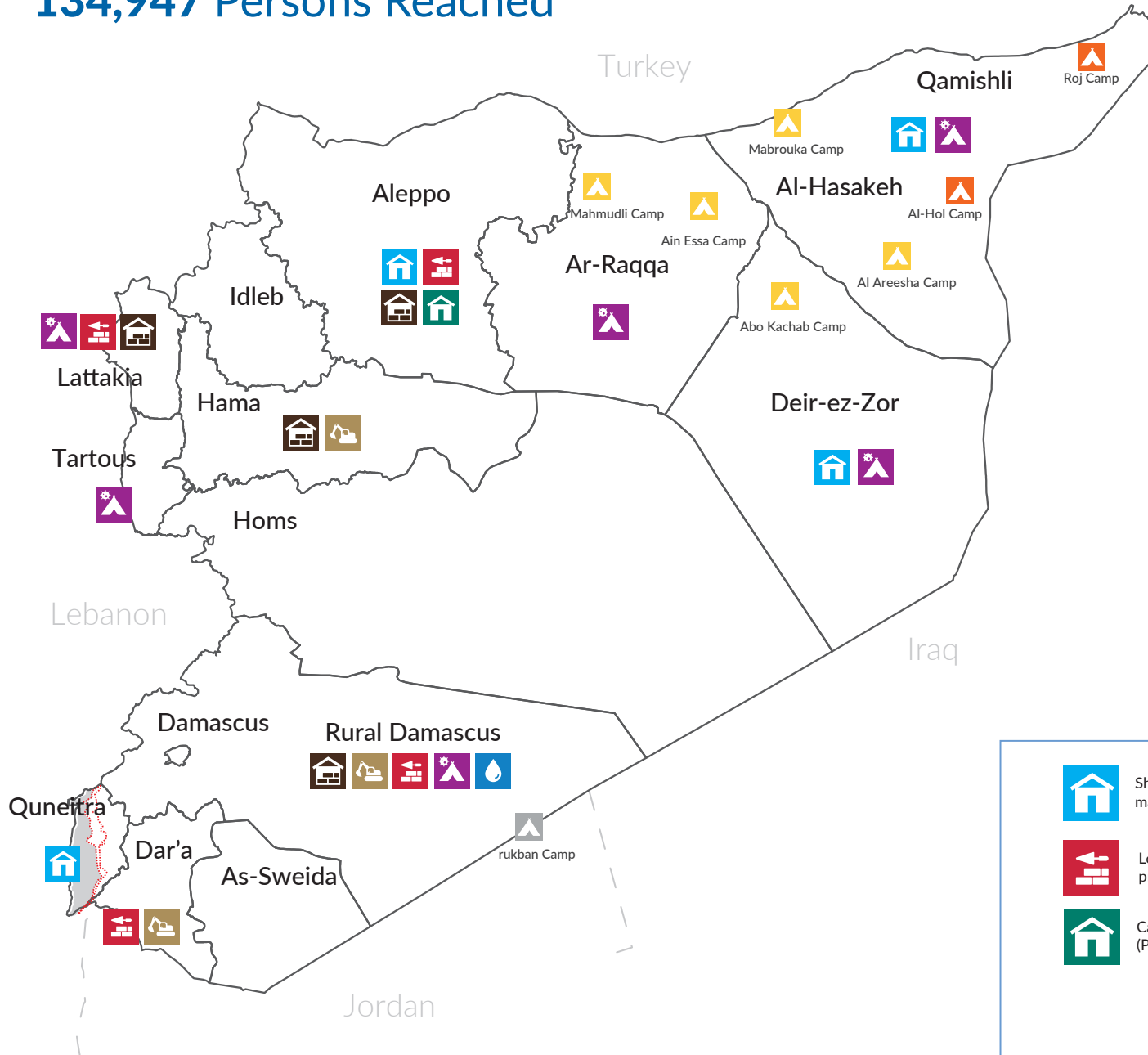


Winterization Distributed Items

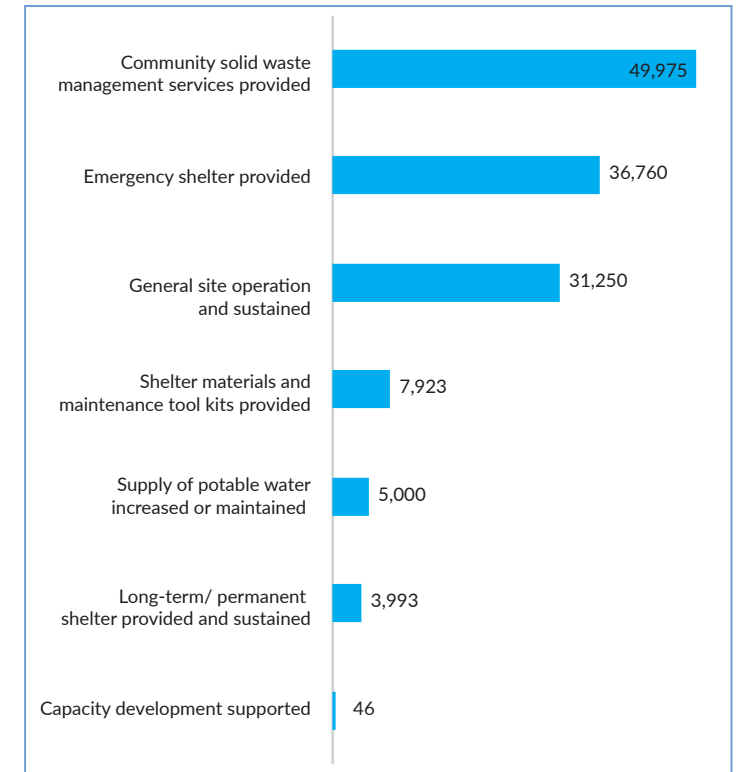


UNHCR SYRIA SHELTER ACTIVITIES

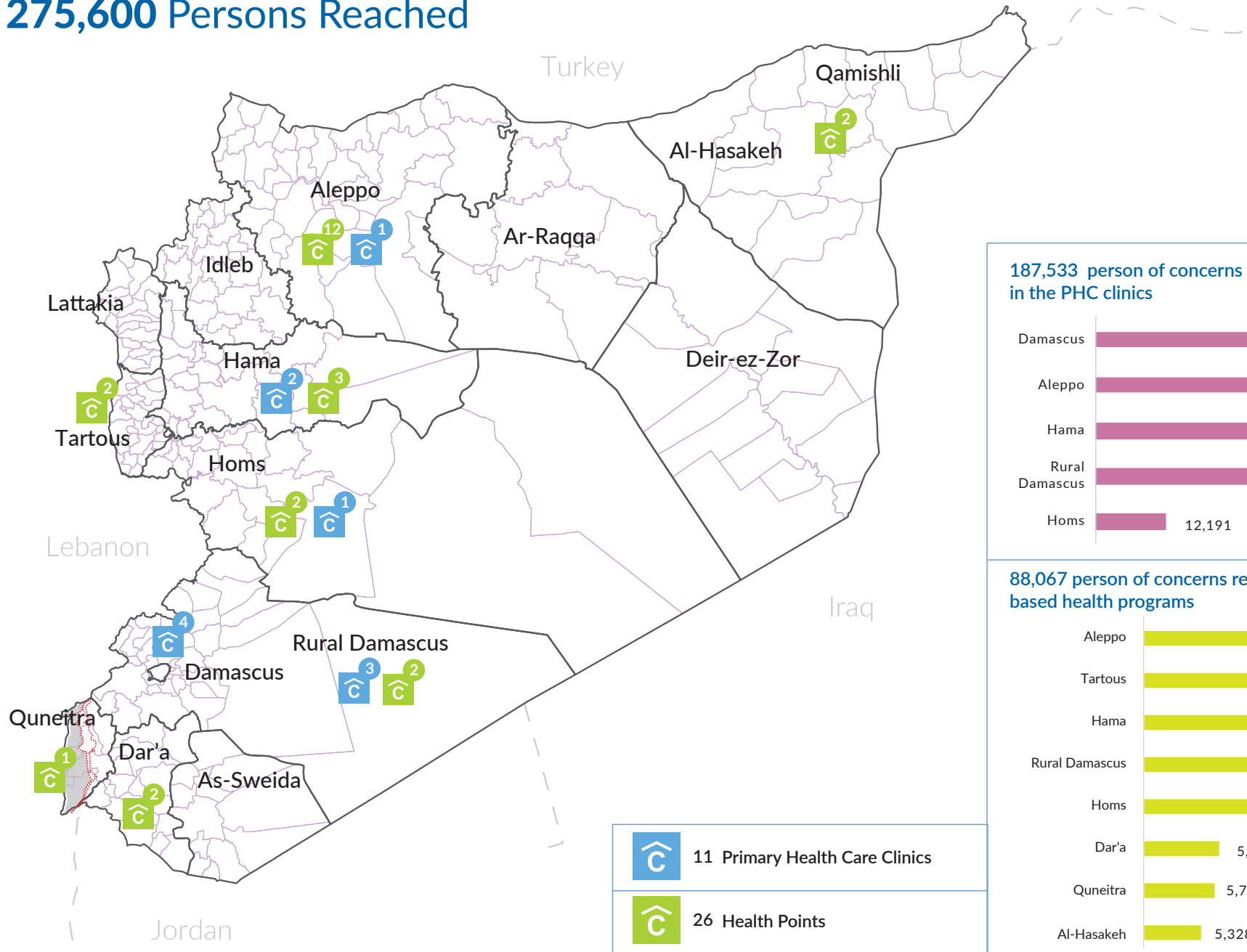


Beneficiaries by Activities

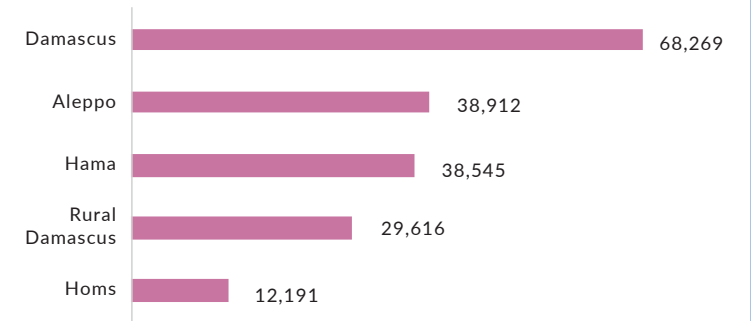

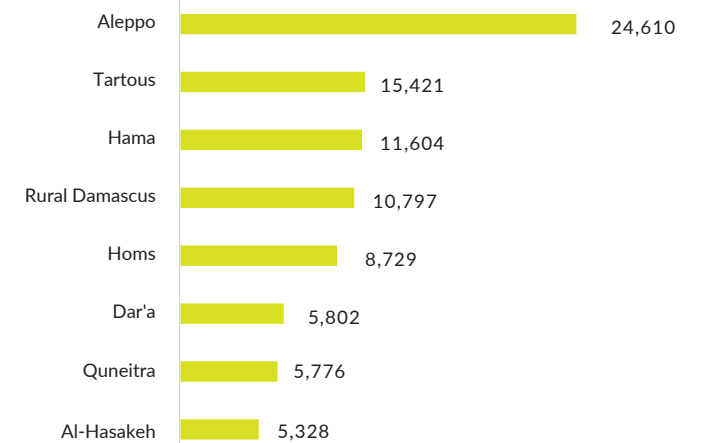

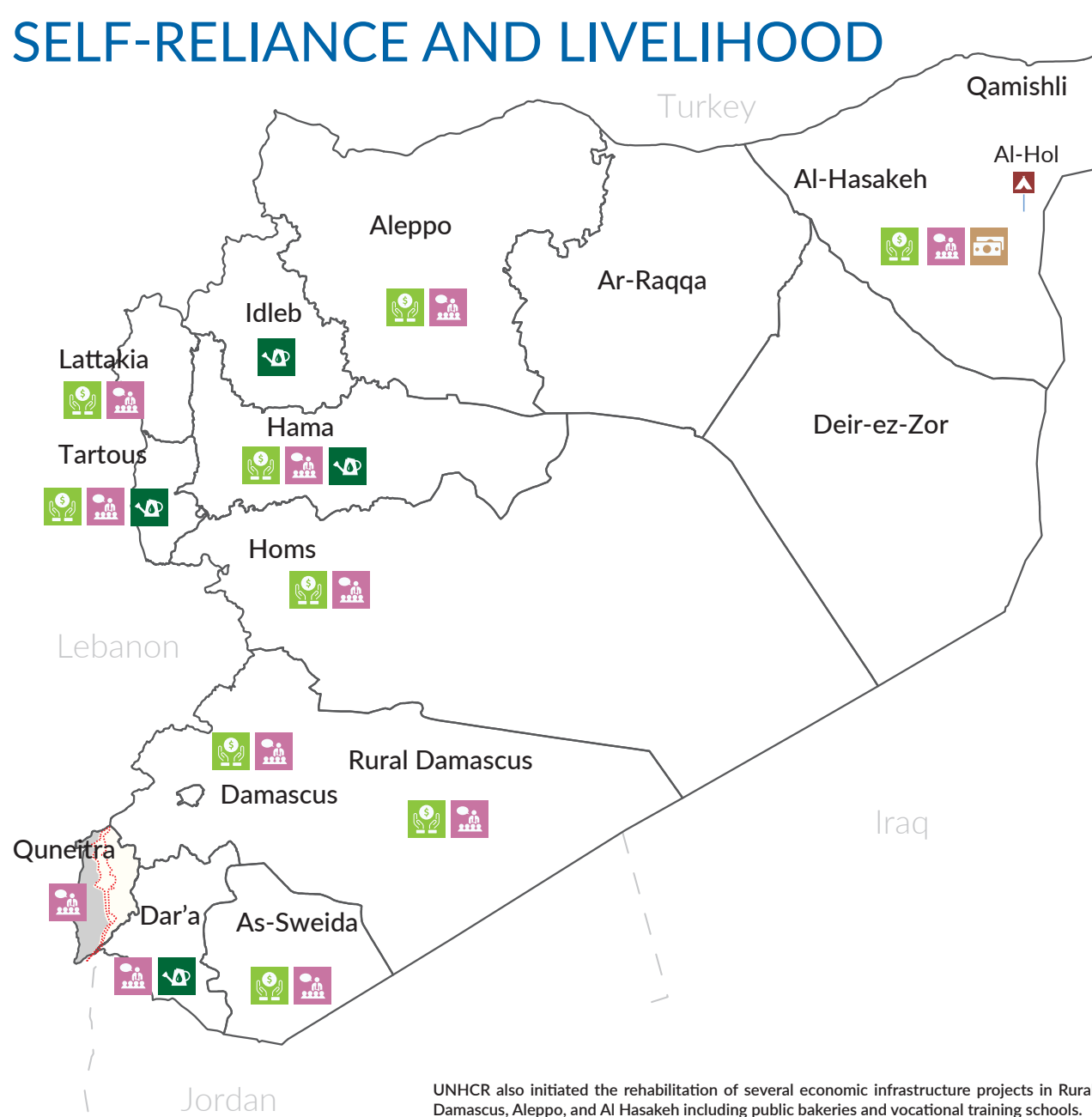

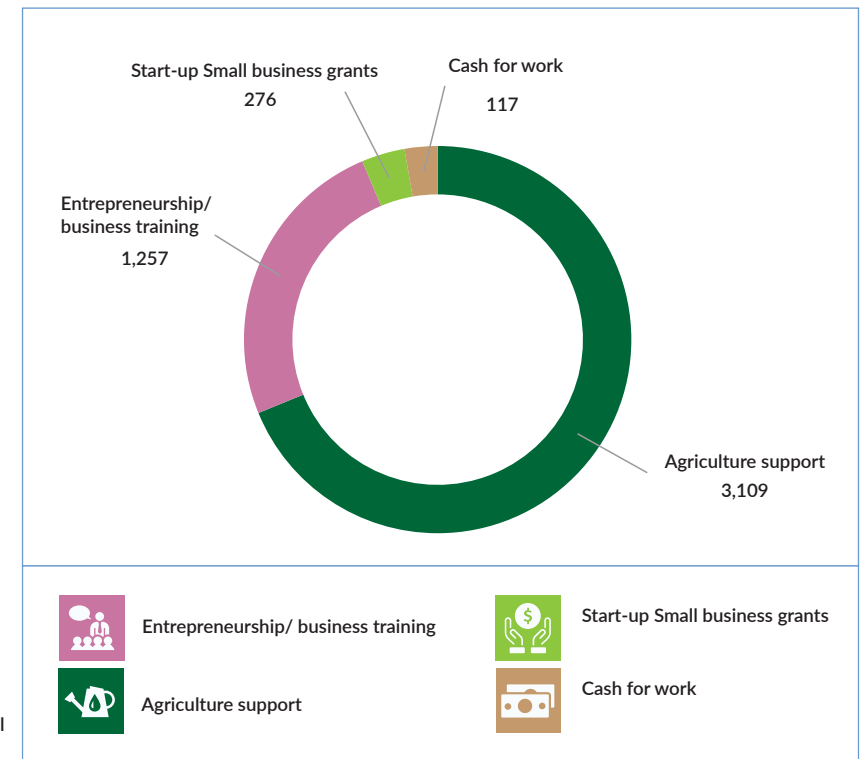

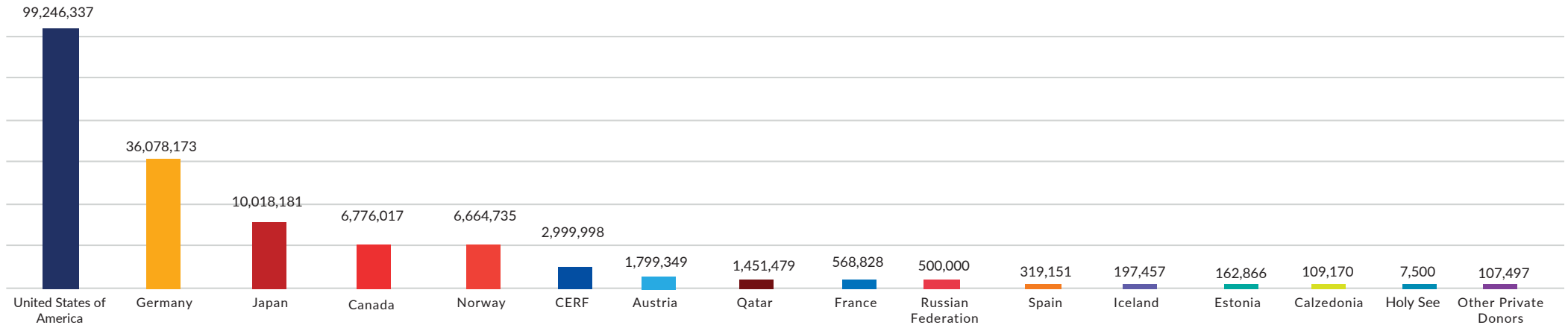
