Brigadier General Norris assumed the position of Cybersecurity Director and Chief Information Security Officer (CISO) in the Office of the Chief Information Officer (CIO), Headquarters, Department of the Army (HQDA) in August 2022.

He is a native of Richmond, Virginia. He received his commission in the Army Signal Corps through the Army Officer Candidate School at Fort Benning, Georgia, in 1991 and has commanded at company to brigade levels. In 2017, he returned to Hawaii to serve as Deputy Commander, 311th Signal Command (Theater) until 2019, then assumed command of the 311th Signal Command (Theater) at Fort Shafter, Hawaii, until July 15, 2022.

He earned a master's degree in Applied Linguistics from Old Dominion University in 1997.
