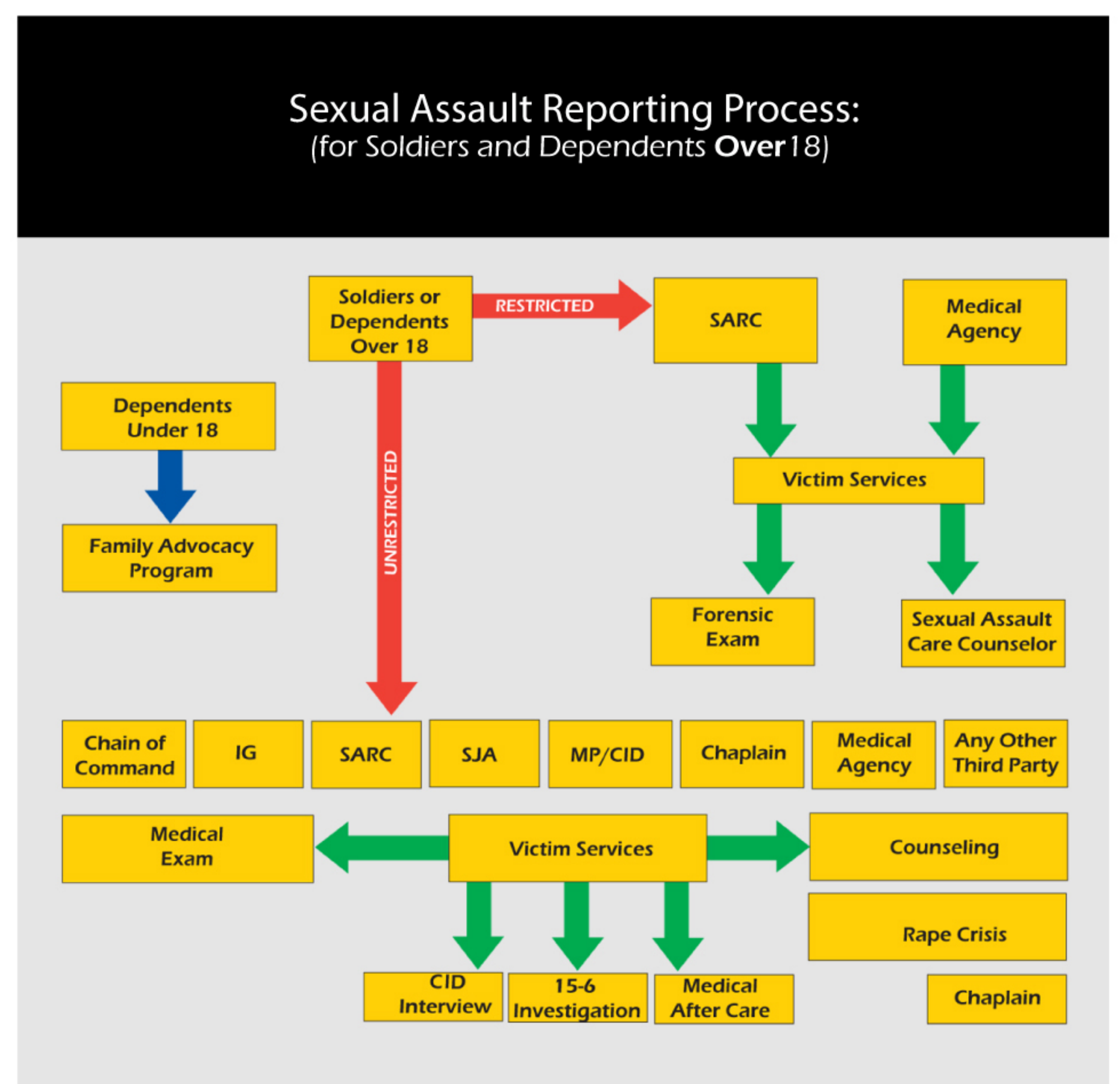
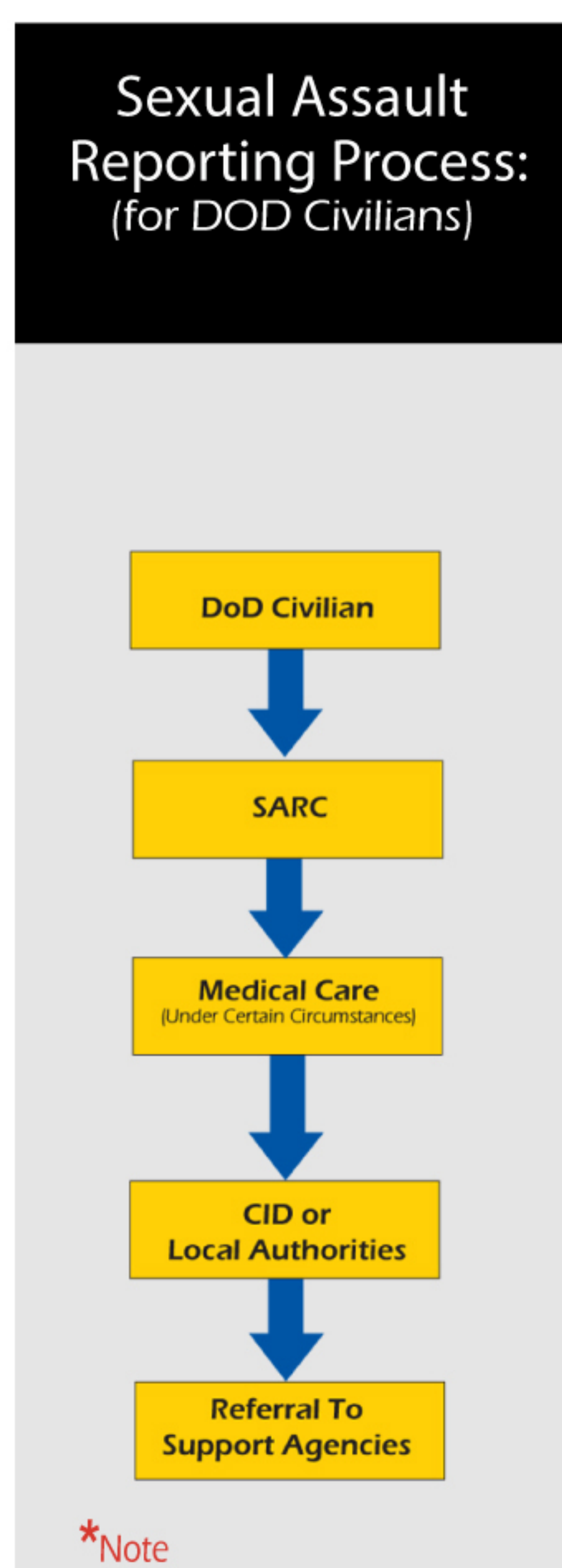
GOALS:

- Accountability – support independent reviews and assessments of the UCMJ provision relating to sexual assault and judicial proceeding in sexual assault cases.
- Assessment – improve data collection and sexual assault reporting capability

(2) DOD civilian in the CONUS & OCONUS will have both options of restricted & unrestricted reporting effective 5 Jan 2017. This change is rescinded at the end of the 1-year trial period.
