WCA Enforcement Issues

Enforcement tools available for non-compliance include:

WCA

- Cease and Desist Order
- Restoration Order
- Replacement Order
- Potential fines for contractors

In the end, if the project specific replacement does not achieve replacement goals, alternative replacement must be secured.

Consequences of Not Following the Process

- ❑ Failure to follow the process results in disqualification from the program and requires the public road authority to follow the Replacement Plan process and provide the required wetland replacement.
- ❑ After-the-fact replacement ratios are double the normally required ratio.
