POST MAJOR STORM BURNS WATERWAY HARBOR APPROACH CHANNEL SURVEY

- 1. A hydrographic survey of the Burns Waterway Harbor approach channel was completed on November 3, 2012 following the major Lake Michigan storm resulting from Hurricane Sandy.
- 2. Shoaling in the approach channel has increased substantially: approximately 2 to 3 feet of additional shoaling formed over a large portion of the channel. The full project depth (-30 feet LWD) is only available over the northern 150 feet of the 400 feet wide approach channel.
- 3. The approach channel survey is posted on the Chicago District Channel Condition Surveys page. http://www.lrc.usace.army.mil/missions/Navigation/ChannelSurveys.aspx
- 4. All of the new survey information will be transmitted to NOAA for updating of the NOAA navigation charts.
