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## The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers, Fort Worth District to host press conference on flood risk management operations at area lakes

**FORT WORTH** – The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers (USACE) Fort Worth District will host a press conference and media availability at Lewisville Lake to provide an update on current operations as it continues its mission to reduce the risk of flooding in the Dallas/Fort Worth metroplex.

Six lakes and two levee systems comprise the area's flood risk management system. The lakes include Ray Roberts, Lewisville, Joe Pool, Benbrook, Grapevine and Lavon, while the levee systems include both the Dallas Floodway System and the Fort Worth levees.

District leadership will provide an update on current operations, field questions and provide a tour of ongoing operations at the Lewisville Lake spillway. Leadership will also accommodate individual interview requests.

The event will begin at 1:30 p.m. at the Lewisville Lake office, located at 1801 N. Mill St., Lewisville, Texas 75057.
