- The Sexual Violence Support & Experiences Study (SVSES) is a confidential and voluntary study about Service members' experiences with support services, aspects of the military justice process, health, well-being, and career progression.

Who can join this CONFIDENTIAL study?

- Anyone who has experienced sexual assault while serving in the U.S. Military (Active, Reserve, or National Guard).

How will sharing my experiences help?
