SUBJECT: 2020 Election and Changes in State Drug Laws

While several states have made changes to their State drug laws during this year's election, I would like to reiterate, that there have been no changes to the drug testing panel under the federal Drug-Free Workplace Program (DFWP). The DFWP (as established under Executive Order 12564, Public Law 100-71 and the Mandatory Guidelines) will continue to test for Schedule I and Schedule II controlled substances at the established cut off levels listed in the Mandatory Guidelines.
